# Rita and Ulrikke

Soft Toys

## MATERIALS

### Honey Bunny

1 skein of col Mulberry (55)  
1 skein of col Silver (118)  
1 skein of col White (01)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US/J10)  
2 safety noses (16 mm)  
4 safety eyes (14 mm)  
Fiberfill  
Black scrap yarn to embroider around the eyes

## YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii

100% Polyester  
100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

## GAUGE

10 x 10 cm / 4 x 4" = 8 st x 9 rows

## ABBREVIATIONS

Sc = single crochet  
Mr = magic ring  
St(s) = stitch(es)  
Sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)  
Ch = chain st  
col = color

## SIZES

One-size

## MEASUREMENTS

30 cm (12").

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Rita the Fox and Ulrikke the Wolf are best friends.

The pattern is the same whether you choose to crochet Rita or Ulrikke. Legs and arms are crocheted directly onto the body to reduce assembly work later.

I recommend embroidering the eyes if the toy is to be used by children under 3 years old.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

Start by crocheting arms and legs, then the body. The arms and legs are crocheted directly onto the body, so you don't have to sew them on afterwards. When crocheting on the pieces, crochet through the round on the piece and the body.

### Arm x 2

*In col (01)*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3-5 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (12)

Rnd 6: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (8)

Change col to (118) / (55)

Rnds 7-11 (5 rounds): 1 sc in each st (8)

Stuff slightly, pinch the round together and sl st to close:

Rnd 12: sl st 4 (4)

Fasten off.

### Leg x 2

*In col (01)*

Rnd. 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc one st\* (18)

Rnds 4-5 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 6: 3 sc, (sc2tog x 3), 9 sc (15)

Rnd 7: 2 sc, (sc2tog x3), 7 sc (12)

Change col to (118) / (55)

Rnds 8-13 (6 rounds): 1 sc in each st (12)

Stuff tightly, pinch the round together and sl st to close:

Rnd 14: sl st 6 = (6)

## Body

*In col (118) / (55)*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc one st\* (18)

Rnd 4: \*2 sc, 2 sc one st\* (24)

Rnd 5: \*3 sc, 2 sc one st\* (30)

Now crochet the legs onto the body by crocheting through the last round on the legs and the body:

Rnd 6: 6 sc, attach leg (6), 10 sc, attach leg (6), 2 sc (30)

Rnds 7-9 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 10: \*3 sc, sc2tog\* (24)

Rnds 11-13 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 14: \*2 sc, sc2tog\* (18)

Rnds 15-16 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (18)

Now crochet the arms onto the body by crocheting through the last round on the arms and the body:

Rnd 17: 3 sc, attach arm (4), 6 sc, attach arm (4), 1 sc (18)

Rnd 18: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (12)

Rnd 19: 1 sc in each st (12)

End with a sl st, fasten off and weave in the end.

Stuff the body.

## Tail

*In col (01)*

Rnd 1: 5 sc in a mr. (5)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (10)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in each st (10)

Change col to (118) / (55)

Rnds 4-7 (4 rounds): 1 sc in each st (10)

Rnd 8: (1 sc, sc2tog) x 3, 1 sc (7)

Stuff

Rnd 9: 1 sc in each st (7)

Rnd 10: sc2tog, 2 sc, sc2tog, 1 sc (5)

Rnds 11-14: (4 rounds): 1 sc in each st (5)

Stuff, end with a sl st and fasten off with a long thread to sew onto the body.

## Snout

*In col (118) / (55)*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Now crochet one half of the snout in col (118) / fv (55) and the other should in col (01).

Rnd 2: (2 sc in one st) x 3, change col to (01): (2 sc in one st) x 3 (12)

Rnd 3: Change col to (118) / (55): 6 sc, change col to (01): 6 sc (12)

Rnd 4: Change col to (118) / (55): (1 sc, 2 sc in one st) x 3, change col to (01): (1 sc, 2 sc in one st) x 3\* (18)

Rnd 5: Change col to (118) / (55), 9 sc, change col to (01): 9 sc (18)

Rnd 6: Change col to (118) / (55): (2 sc, 2 sc in one st) x 3, change col to (01): (2 sc, 2 sc in one st) x 3 (24)

Work only 1 sc in the last round to change color so that the snout can be sewn onto the head with the same color as the head.

Rnd 7: Change col to (118) / (55): 1 sc

End with a sl st and a long thread to sew onto the head.

## Ear x 2

*In col (118) / (55)*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*1 sc, 2 sc one st\* (9)

Rnd 3: \*2 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 4: \*5 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (14)

Rnd 5: \*6 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (16)

Rnd 6: \*7 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (18)

End with a sl st and a long thread to sew onto the head.

## Head

*In col (118) / (55)*

Rnds 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc one st\* (18)

Rnd 4: \*2 sc, 2 sc one st\* (24)

Rnd 5: \*3 sc, 2 sc one st\* (30)

Rnds 6-12 (7 rounds): 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 13: \*3 sc, sc2tog\* (24)

Rnd 14: \*2 sc, sc2tog\* (18)

Rnd 15: \*1 sc, sc2tog\*(12)

End with a sl st and fasten off with a long thread to sew the head and body together.  
Stuff the head.

## Assembly

*Use the picture below as a guide*

Place a safety nose on the snout between rounds 2 and 3 at the top center. Press the snout flat to form a triangle. Stuff the snout slightly and sew the snout onto the head, the upper part between rnds 10 and 11, and the lower part between rnds 13 and 14, stuff as you go.

Attach the safety eyes in the head right above the snout.



Press the ears flat so that they form a triangle, sew them onto the head between rnds 2 and 9.

Embroider details around the eyes with white and black yarn.

Embroider eyebrows.

Sew the head onto the body, remember to stuff as you go to prevent a wobbly head.

Sew the tail on between rnds 6 and 7 on the body.
