# Max

Soft Toy

## MATERIALS

### Honey Bunny

1 skein of col Caramel (14)  
1 skein of col Chocolate (12)  
1 skein of col White (01)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US/J10)  
2 safety eyes (14 mm)  
Fiberfill  
White scrap yarn to embroider around the eyes

## YARN QUALITY

 **Honey Bunny**, Hobbii  
100% Polyester  
100 g (3.50 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

## GAUGE

10 x 10 cm (4" x 4") = 8 sts x 9 rws

## ABBREVIATIONS

Sc = single crochet  
Mr = magic ring  
St(s) = Stitch(es)  
Sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)  
Ch = chain  
Lp st = loop stitch

## SIZES

One-size

## MEASUREMENTS

30 cm (12")

## PATTERN INFORMATION

Max the Mammoth is a cute and soft cuddly friend

Legs and arms are crocheted directly onto the body to minimize assembly work afterwards. To make Max's fur you will have to make a lot of loop stitches.

I recommend embroidering the eyes if the toy is to be used by children under 3 years old.

# Pattern instructions



## INFO AND TIPS

Begin with the arms and legs and then the body. The arms and legs are crocheted directly onto the body, so you don't have to sew them on afterwards. When crocheting on the pieces, crochet through the round on the piece and the body. The loop stitches you are going to make when finishing the body must be tightened firmly.

## Loop stitch

1. Make a loop: Pull the yarn up to the desired length to form a loop.
2. Keep the loop in place: Use your fingers to hold the loop so it doesn't slip back.
3. Single crochet: Insert the hook into the same stitch where the loop comes from, yarn over, and pull through the loop. Yarn over again and pull through both loops on the hook.
4. Repeat: Continue by making a new loop and then a single crochet in each stitch or following the pattern. Watch a video here:

## Arm x 2

*In color 14*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnds 3-5 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (12)

Rnd 6 \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (8)

*Change col to 12*

Rnds 7-8 (2 rounds): 1 lp st in each st (8)

*Change col to 14*

Rnds 9-11 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (8)

Stuff slightly, pinch the round together and sl st to close:

Rnd 12: sl st 4 (4)

Fasten off.

## Leg x 2

*In col 14*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (18)  
Rnds 4-5 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (18)  
Rnd 6: 3 sc, sc2tog x 3, 9 sc (15)  
Rnd 7: 2 sc, (sc2tog x3), 7 sc (12)  
*Change col to 12*  
Rnds 8-9 (2 rounds): 1 lp st in each st (12)  
*Change col to 14*  
Rnds 10-13 (4 rounds): 1 sc in each st (12)

Stuff well, pinch the round together and sl st to close:  
Rnd 14: sl st 6 (6)

Fasten off.

## Body

*In col 14*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)  
Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)  
Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (18)  
Rnd 4: \*2 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (24)  
Rnd 5: \*3 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (30)

Now crochet the legs onto the body by crocheting sc through the last round on the legs and through the body:

Rnd 6: 6 sc, attach leg (6), 10 sc, attach leg (6), 2 sc (30)

Rnds 7-9 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (30)  
Rnd 10: \*3 sc, sc2tog\* (24)  
Rnds 11-14 (4 rounds): 1 sc in each st (24)  
Rnd 15: \*2 sc, sc2tog\* (18)  
Rnd 16: 1 sc in each st (18)  
Rnd 17: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (12)

*Change col to 12*

Rnd 18: 1 lp st in each st (12)

Now crochet the arms onto the body by crocheting through the last round on the arms and through the body:

Rnd 19: 2 lp sts, attach arm (4), 2 lp sts, attach arm (4). (12)

Rnd 20: \*1 lp st in each st \*(12)

End with a sl st, fasten off, weave in ends.

Stuff the body.

## Tail

*In color 12*

Rnd 1: 5 sc in a mr (5)  
Rnds 2-3 (2 rounds): 1 lp st in each st (5)

*Change col to 14*

Rnds 4-6 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (5)

Don't stuff, pinch together, sl st 2 to close and fasten off with a long thread to sew onto the body.

## **Ear x 2**

*In color 14*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (18)

Rnd 4: \*2 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (24)

Rnd 5: \*3 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (30)

End with a sl st and a long thread to sew onto the head.

## **Head**

*In color 12*

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 lp sts in each st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 lp st, 2 lp sts in one st\* (18)

Rnd 4: \*2 lp sts, 2 lp sts in one st\* (24)

Rnd 5: \*3 lp sts, 2 lp sts in one st\* (30)

*Change col to 14*

Rnds 6-11 (6 rounds): 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 12: 11 sc, skip 6 sts, 13 sc (24)

Rnd 13: \*2 sc, sc2tog\* (18)

Rnd 14: \*1 sc, sc2tog\*(12)

End with a sl st and fasten off with a long thread to sew the head and body together.

Stuff the head.

## **Trunk**

*In col 14*

Stuff the trunk as you go.

Attach the yarn in the 6 skipped sts from rnd 12 on the head as follows:

Rnd 1: 2 sc in one st, 4 sc, 2 sc in one st (8)

Rnds 2-7 (6 rounds): 1 sc in each st (8)

Rnd 8: sc2tog, 4 sc, sc2tog (6)

Rnds 9-12 (4 rounds): 1 sc in each st (4)

Pinch the round together and sl st to close:

Rnd 13: sl st 2 (2)

Fasten off.

## **Tusks x 2**

*In color 01*



Rnd 1: 5 sc in a mr (5)

Rnds 2-4 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (5)

End with a sl st and a long thread to sew onto the head.

### Assembly

Lightly fold the ears in half and sew together with a few stitches at the bottom. Then sew them onto the head between rnds 6 and 7.

Sew the tusks on under the trunk on either side.

Attach the safety eyes in the head between rnds 7 and 8.

Embroider details around the eyes with white yarn.

Sew the head onto the body, remember to stuff before finishing completely.  
Sew the tail on between rnds 6 and 7 on the body.
