

**CROCHET PATTERN**

### **MATERIALS**

1 skein of **Honey Bunny** col Silver (118)

Crochet hook 6 mm (US/J10) 1 safety nose (12 mm) 2 safety eyes (14 mm) black and white scrap yarn to embroider around the eyes.

# YARN QUALITY

Honey Bunny, Hobbii 100% Polyester 100 g (3.5 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

### **GAUGE**

 $10 \times 10 \text{ cm} / 4 \times 4'' = 8 \text{ st } \times 9 \text{ rows}$ 

### **ABBREVIATIONS**

Sc = single crochet
Mr = magic ring
St(s) = stitch(es)
Sl st(s) = slip stitch(es)
Ch = chain

#### **SIZES**

One-size

### **MEASUREMENTS**

Length: 30 cm (12").

### PATTERN INFORMATION

Kitty the cat is a sweet and soft cat that is ready to become your new pet.

Legs and arms are crocheted directly onto the body to minimize assembly work afterwards. If you use safety eyes, make sure you use ones that are large enough to fit properly without falling out of the holes. I recommend a minimum of 9 mm, but this depends on your crochet gauge.

I recommend embroidering the eyes if the toy is to be used by children under 3 years old.

# **Pattern**







## **INFO AND TIPS**

Start by crocheting arms and legs, then the body. The arms and legs are crocheted directly onto the body, so you don't have to sew them on afterwards. When crocheting on the pieces, crochet through the round on the piece and the body.

## Arm x 2

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6) Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnds 3-5 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (12)

Rnd 6: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (8)

Rnds 7-11 (5 rounds): 1 sc in each st (8)

Stuff a little, pinch the round together and sl st to close:

Rnd 12: sl st 4 (4)

Fasten off.

## Legs x 2

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc one a st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (18)

Rnds 4-5 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (18)

Rnd 6: 3 sc, (sc2tog x 3), 9 sc (15)

Rnd 7: 2 sc, (sc2tog x3), 7 sc (12)

Rnds 8-13 (6 rounds): 1 sc in each st (12)

Stuff tightly, pinch the round together and sl st to close:

Rnd 14: 6 sl st = (6)

## **Body**

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6) Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc one a st\* (18)



Rnd 4: \*2 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (24) Rnd 5: \*3 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (30)

Now crochet the legs onto the body by crocheting through the last round on the legs and the body:

Rnd 6: 6 sc, attach leg (6), 10 sc, attach leg (6), 2 sc (30)

Rnds 7-9 (3 rounds): 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 10: \*3 sc, sc2tog\* (24)

Rnds 11-12 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (24)

Rnd 13: \*2 sc, sc2tog\* (18)

Rnds 14-15 (2 rounds): 1 sc in each st (18)

Now crochet the arms onto the body by crocheting through the last round on the arms and the body:

Rnd 16: 3 sc, attach arm (4), 6 sc, attach arm (4), 1 sc (18)

Rnd 17: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (12)

End with a sl st, fasten off and weave in the end.

Stuff the body.

### Tail

Rnd 1: 5 sc in a mr (5)

Rnds 2-27 (26 rounds): 1 sc in each st (5)

Don't stuff, end with a sl st and fasten off with a long thread to sew onto the body.

### Snout

Ch 6, turn, begin in 2<sup>nd</sup> ch from the hook:

Rnd 1: 4 sc, 3 sc in one st, continue on the other side of the chain, 4 sc, 3 sc in one st (14)

Rnd 2: 4 sc, 2 sc in one st, 1 sc, 2 sc in one st, 4 sc, 2 sc in one st, 1 sc, 2 sc in one st (18)

Rnd 3: 1 sc in each st (18)

End with a sl st and long thread to sew onto the head.

### Ear x 2

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*1 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (9)

Rnd 3: \*2 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 4: \*5 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (14)

Rnd 5: \*6 sc. 2 sc in one st\* (16)

Rnd 6: \*7 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (18)

End with a sl st and a long thread to sew onto the head.

### Head

Rnd 1: 6 sc in a mr (6)

Rnd 2: \*2 sc in one st\* (12)

Rnd 3: \*1 sc, 2 sc in one st\* (18)

Rnd 4: \*2 sc, 2 sc one st\* (24)

Rnd 5: \*3 sc, 2 sc one st\* (30)



Rnds 6-12 (7 rounds): 1 sc in each st (30)

Rnd 13: \*3 sc, sc2tog\* (24) Rnd 14: \*2 sc, sc2tog\* (18) Rnd 15: \*1 sc, sc2tog\* (12)

End with a sl st and fasten off with a long thread to sew the head and body together. Stuff the head.

# **Assembly**

Press the ears flat so that they form a triangle. Sew them onto the head between rnds 2 and 9

Place a safety snout at the top center of the snout. Stuff the snout slightly and sew the snout on between rnds 11-13. Stuff as you go.

Once the snout is sewn on, sew the thread from just under the nose to the bottom of the snout to shape the snout so that it is split in two.

Place the safety eyes on the head just above the snout so that the safety nose is in the center between the eyes. Embroider details around the eyes with white and black yarn. Embroider eyebrows.

Embroider whiskers.

Sew the head onto the body, remember to stuff before closing completely. Sew the tail on between rnds 6 and 7 on the body.
