## MATERIALS

5 skeins of **Friends Kid Silk** color 02 2 skeins of **Pearly Haze** color 04

Crochet hook 5.5 mm / US I/9 Crochet hook 10 mm / US P/15

# YARN QUALITY

Friends Kid Silk, Hobbii
72 % Mohair, 25 % Silk, 3% Wool
25 g / 0.9 oz = 200 m / 218 yds

#### Pearly Haze, Hobbii

73 % Viscose, 27 % Wool 50 g / 1.75 oz = 110 m / 120 yds

# GAUGE

10 sts x 8 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4" Kid Silk - hdc blo

18 sts x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4" Pearly Haze - hdc sl st blo

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain sc = single crochet sl st = slip stitch hdc = half double crochet blo = back loop only hdc sl st = half double crochet slip stitch: •• How to Crochet | Half Double Crochet Sli...

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### SIZE

One size

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Collar Circumference: 43 cm / 17" Keep in mind that it is super stretchy to fit all sizes.

Collar Length: 13 cm / 5" Cape length: 48 cm / 19" (customizable)

# PATTERN INFORMATION

This fun and fluffy crochet pattern is perfect for any special celebration! Whether you're getting dressed up for a wedding, a bachelorette party, or just want to feel fancy, this collar-and-cape combo will make you look and feel amazing.

This design is made with super soft Kid Silk, which gives it that dreamy, lightweight, and cozy vibe. You'll start by crocheting the collar and then move on to the body, which uses a larger hook for that flowy, stretchy look.

The pattern is beginner-friendly but still interesting enough to keep things exciting, so if you've got a little crochet experience, you'll love making this! Perfect for weddings, fancy parties, or just dressing up, this design is stretchy, comfy, and sure to make you feel extra special.

# Pattern




## COLLAR

Start with pearly haze and a 5.5 mm hook. Ch 41. Crochet in rows.

R1: Starting from the 2nd ch from the hook, hdc sl st 40. (40) R2-R53: ch 1, turn, hdc sl st blo 40. (40)

Join the first and last row with slip stitches creating a long tube. Fold the tube in half lengthwise to create a double-layered thick collar. Make a single crochet border of 53 sc sts to close the bottom of the collar. Do not fasten off.



# BODY

R1: Ch 1, turn, inc with hdc in all sts, sl st to join the round. (106) Fasten off. Continue with two strands of Kid Silk and a 10 mm hook.

Reattach the yarn where you left off and chain 35, then continue working in rows.

**Tip:** The number of chains determines the length of your cape, so feel free to adjust by adding or removing chains to suit your style. Also, keep your half-double crochet (hdc) stitches loose for a soft, flowy finish.



R1: starting from the 2nd ch from the hook, hdc 34. Then sl st 2 into the collar. (34)R2: turn your project, hdc blo 34. (34)R3: ch 1, turn, hdc blo 34, sl st 2 into the next 2 sts of the collar. (34)R4-R106: Repeat row 2 and 3.

Join the first and last row with slip stitches. Fasten off and weave in the ends.
