MATERIALS

Baby Cotton Organic, 1 skein of each colour:

Cream (02), Titanium (04), Baby Pink (12), Pure Undyed (15), Dusty Rose (21), Pastel Yellow (27)

Hobbii Embroidery Yarn in col. 900 and col. 100

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US 4/0 Stitch marker Scissors Yarn Needle

YARN QUALITY

Baby Cotton Organic, Hobbii 100% Organic Egyptian Cotton, 50 g (1.75 oz) = 170 m (185 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

MR = Magic Ring

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

bo = bobble stitch

slst = slip stitch

RS = Right Side

WS = Wrong Side

inc = increase

dec = decrease

hdc = half double crochet

() = made in the same stitch

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height of the beanie: approx. 5 cm / 2" (without ears and earflap)
Width of the beanie: approx. 6 cm / 2.25"

Hats fit standard sized eggs.

Create adorable egg hats perfect for Easter and spring decorations! This pattern includes designs for a lamb, bunny, chicken and chick, all crafted in soft pastel colours. INFO AND TIPS

- Read the pattern before starting to crochet.
- Crochet in continuous, spiral rounds unless otherwise stated in the pattern.
- Always mark the beginning of each round using a stitch marker.
- Pattern is written for intermediate skill level and doesn't contain tutorials for stitches except for the special stitches.
- Try to keep a rather loose fit. If your stitches are too tight switch your hook to a larger one.

Bobble Stitch: Yarn over, insert the hook into the indicated stitch, yarn over and pull through. Yarn over, pull through the first 2 loops on the hook. Repeat this process 3 more times until you have 5 loops on your hook. Pull through all 5 loops.

Bobble stitch puffs on the WS of your work and you see the back of all stitches while working so after you'll finish your work, turn it WS out so all bobbles will be visible. Then continue your work as follows.

Braided tails (optional)

Cut three approx. 20 cm / 7.75" long pieces of yarn in main colour. Pass through last space in earflap. You should now have 6 strands to braid with.

Make a knot and braid approx. 3 – 4 cm / 1.25 - 1.5". make a knot, trim ends.



Cute Lamb



Beanie

With col.15

Rnd 1: 8sc into MR (8)

Rnd 2: [sc, (bo, sc)] x4 (12)

Rnd 3: 12sc (12)

Rnd 4: [(bo, sc), sc] x6 (18)

Rnd 5: 18sc (18)

Rnd 6: [(bo, sc), sc] x9 (27)

Rnd 7: 27sc (27)

Rnd 8: (bo, sc) x13, sc (27)

Rnd 9: 27sc (27)

Rnd 10: (sc, bo) x13, sc (27)

Rnd 11: 27sc (27)

Rnd 12: (bo, sc) x13, sc (27)

Rnd 13: 27sc (27)

Do not fasten off, continue with **first earflap**

Row 1: as continued from Round 13. Work 1sc into each of next 6sts. Ch1, turn. (6)

Row 2: scdec, 2sc, scdec, ch1, turn (4)

Row 3: 1sc into each of next 4sts, ch1, turn (4)

Row 4: scdec x2 (2) Row 5: scdec and ch1

Fasten off and weave in ends

Second earflap

Fold hat in half leaving 8 stitches in the front of the hat and 6 stitches on the back. Place the second earflap to line up with the first earflap.



Row 1: Attach yarn and work ch1 and 1sc into the same stitch, then make 1sc into each of next

5sts. Ch1, turn (6)

Row 2: scdec, 2sc, scdec, ch1, turn (4)

Row 3: 1sc into each of next 4sts, ch1, turn (4)

Row 4: scdec x2 (2) Row 5: scdec and ch1

Do not fasten off, continue row of sc around the edge of the hat and around both earflaps. Fasten off and weave all ends.

Ear

Make 4 pieces, two in col. 12 and two in a col. 15. Each ear is made with two pieces joined together.

Ch6

Rnd 1: Start from the 2nd chain from the hook, work 1sc in each of next 4 chains. Work 3sc in last ch then 4sc down the other side of the chains.

Rnd 2: 1sc in each of next 3sts, 1hdc in next 2sts, 3hdc in next st, 1hdc in next 2sts, 1sc in each of next 3sts. Join to first sc with slst.

Join two pieces WS together and make round of sc around the edge. Slst into the first sc. Fasten off leaving a long tail.

Finishing Touches

Sew the ears on to both sides of the hat, just over the earflaps.



Cute Bunny



Beanie

With col. 04

Rnd 1: MR, 6sc (6)

Rnd 2: scinc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: (sc, scinc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

Rnd 6: (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

Rnd 7 - Rnd 16: 1sc in each stitch around – 10 rounds (36)

Do not fasten off, continue with **first earflap**

Row 1: as continued from Round 16. Work 1sc into each of next 6sts. Ch1, turn. (6)

Row 2: scdec, 2sc, scdec, ch1, turn (4)

Row 3: 1sc into each of next 4sts, ch1, turn (4)

Row 4: scdec x2 (2)

Row 5: scdec and ch1

Fasten off and weave in ends

Second earflap

Fold hat in half leaving 14 stitches in the front of the hat and 10 stitches on the back. Place the second earflap to line up with the first earflap.

Row 1: Attach yarn and work ch1 and 1sc into the same stitch, then make 1sc into each of next 5sts. Ch1, turn (6)

Row 2: scdec, 2sc, scdec, ch1, turn (4)

Row 3: 1sc into each of next 4sts, ch1, turn (4)

Row 4: scdec x2 (2)



Row 5: scdec and ch1

Do not fasten off, continue row of sc around the edge of the hat and around both earflaps. Fasten off and weave all ends.

Ear (make 2)

With col. 04

Rnd 1: MR, 6sc (6)

Rnd 2: (sc, scinc) x3 (9)

Rnd 3: (2sc, scinc) x3 (12)

Rnd 4 - Rnd 7: 1sc in each stitch around - 4 rounds (12)

Rnd 8: (2sc, scdec) x3 (9)

Rnd 9 - Rnd 12: 1sc in each stitch around - 4 rounds (9)

Rnd 13: (sc, scdec) x3 (6)

Rnd 14: 1sc in each stitch around (6)

Flat the ears, fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Finishing Touches

Sew the ears on the top of the hat.

You can embroider a little eyes and face at the front of the hat (optional).



Cute Chick and the Chicken

With col. 02 for the chicken and col. 27 for the chick.





Beanie

Rnd 1: MR, 6sc (6)

Rnd 2: scinc x6 (12)

Rnd 3: (sc, scinc) x6 (18)

Rnd 4: (2sc, scinc) x6 (24)

Rnd 5: (3sc, scinc) x6 (30)

Rnd 6: (4sc, scinc) x6 (36)

Rnd 7 - Rnd 16: 1sc in each stitch around - 10 rounds (36)

Do not fasten off, continue with **first earflap**

Row 1: as continued from Round 16. Work 1sc into each of next 6sts. Ch1, turn. (6)

Row 2: scdec, 2sc, scdec, ch1, turn (4)

Row 3: 1sc into each of next 4sts, ch1, turn (4)

Row 4: scdec x2 (2)

Row 5: scdec and ch1

Fasten off and weave in ends

Second earflap

Fold hat in half leaving 14 stitches in the front of the hat and 10 stitches on the back. Place the second earflap to line up with the first earflap.

Row 1: Attach yarn and work ch1 and 1sc into the same stitch, then make 1sc into each of next 5sts. Ch1, turn (6)

Row 2: scdec, 2sc, scdec, ch1, turn (4)

Row 3: 1sc into each of next 4sts, ch1, turn (4)

Row 4: scdec x2 (2)



Row 5: scdec and ch1

Do not fasten off, continue row of sc around the edge of the hat and around both earflaps. Fasten off and weave all ends.

Comb for chicken

With col. 21

Ch12, sc into second ch from the hook. 4dc into next st, sc, slst, sc, 4dc into next st, sc, slst, sc, 4dc into next st, sc.

Fasten off, leaving a long tail.

Beak (make 2)

With col. 21

Rnd 1: MR, 4sc (4)

Rnd 2: 1sc, scinc, 1sc, scinc (6)

Make slst and fasten off, leaving the WS out. Leave a long tail.

Finishing Touches

For the Chick, make a few safety knots with the main col. on the top of the hat, cut for the desired length and brush lightly.

For the Chicken, sew the comb on the top of the hat.

Sew the beak and embroider the eyes at the front of the hat.
