MATERIALS

Baby Cotton Organic, 1 skein of each colour:

Cream (02), Titanium (04), Mint (09), Baby Pink (12), Pure Undyed (15), Dusty Rose (21), Pastel Yellow (27), Light Denim (41)

Crochet hook 2.5 mm / US 4/0

Stitch marker

Scissors

Yarn Needle

Small amount of stuffing

YARN QUALITY

 **Baby Cotton Organic**, Hobbii

Super Fine, 100% Organic Egyptian Cotton, 50 g (1.75 oz) = 170 m (185 yds)

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

hdc = half double crochet

dc = double crochet

puff = puff stitch

cl = cluster stitch

slst = slip stitch

MR = magic ring

WS = wrong side

tr = treble stitch

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Height: approx. 6 cm / 2.25"

Circumference: approx. 15 cm / 6"

INFO AND TIPS

Make color combinations using the photos as reference or create your own color combinations.

Puff Stitch: ch3, (yarn over, insert hook into the same stitch, yarn over, pull up the loop) 5 times. There will be 11 loops on the hook. To finish the stitch, yarn over and draw through all loops on the hook. Ch2 and slst into the next stitch.

Cluster Stitch: yarn over, insert hook into the indicated stitch, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops, (2 loops left on hook). Yarn over, insert hook back into same space, yarn over, draw up a loop, yarn over, draw through 2 loops, (3 loops left on hook). To finish the stitch, yarn over and draw the yarn through all 3 loops on the hook.

Easter Egg Halves (make 2)

Rnd 1: MR, ch2 (counts as a hdc), 7hdc. Join with the slst into the top of beginning ch2. Change colour. (8)



Rnd 2: ch3 (counts as a dc), 1puff st into the same space, 1puff stitch in each stitch around (8)

The petals are popped on the WS of the flower so before attaching a new colour, turn a flower WS up.



Right Side (RS)



Wrong Side (WS)

Rnd 3: Attach a new colour between the petals on the back post of slst and ch3 (counts as a dc). Make a dc into the same space, then ch2 and another 2dc cl into the same space. Repeat (2dc cl, ch2, 2dc cl) in each back post of slst around. At the end of the round you should have eight 4dc cl groups. Join with the slst into the top of the beginning ch3.



Rnd 4: Attach a new colour between the groups of clusters, ch3 (count as a dc) 1dc into the same space. (1sc into the next space, 2dc into the next space) repeat 7 more times. Join with the slst into the top of the beginning ch3. (24 sts)



Rnd 5: Attach a new colour into any of the stitches and ch1 (counts as a sc), make 6sc, 2hdc, 2dc, 2trinc into each of next two stitches, then 2dc, 2hdc, 7sc. Join with the slst into the beginning ch1. (26 sts)



Rnd 6: Attach a new colour into the top of the 2nd treble from the Rnd 5. In this round, we will join two egg halves together. To do so, grab your egg halves facing WS together and join them by making a round of sc into BL of each stitch. (26 stitches). Before closing, stuff the egg with fiberfill, shaping as you go.



You can fasten off now and leave them as they are or you can chain 15 or longer and then fasten off.
