MATERIALS

Pom Pom x Hobbii Garland

Shade: Muse (23); 6 (7, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 12, 13) balls

4mm / US 6 circular needle, 60-100cm / 24"-40" length depending on size worked, **and** needles suitable for working small circumferences in the round. 4mm / US 6 DPN.

Always use a needle size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

Stitch marker, 9 buttons (1.5cm diameter), tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Garland, Hobbii x Pom Pom
Worsted weight
70% Cotton, 30% Alpaca
105m / 114yd per 50 g

GAUGE

19 sts & 38 rows = 10cm / 4" over Belleview Stitch pattern on 4mm needles after blocking. 22 sts & 25 rows = 10cm / 4" over 1x1 Rib pattern on 4mm needles after blocking.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10)

MEASUREMENTS

Finished chest circumference: 86 (99, 105, 117.5, 124, 136.5, 149.5, 155.5, 168.5, 174.5)cm / 34 (39, 41½, 46½, 49, 54, 58¾ 61¼, 66¼, 68¾)" – to be worn with 8-13cm / 3-5" positive ease.

Model has a 96.5cm / 38" chest circumference and is wearing a size 3.

PATTERN INFORMATION

Belleview is worked from the bottom up in one piece to the underarm. The fronts and back are then divided and worked separately to the shoulder. The shoulders are joined with a three-needle cast-off. Sleeves are worked in the round from the cuff to the underarm, then the sleeve cap is worked flat before being sewn into the armholes. Stitches are picked up to work the ribbed buttonbands and neck edging.

Belleview Stitch (flat)

Worked over 6 sts + 1 **Row 1 (RS):** [K1, p5] to last st, k1. **Row 2 (WS):** [P1, k5] to last st, p1. **Rows 3-4:** Rep rows 1-2.

Row 5: K1, p5, *drop the next knit st from the LH needle and unravel 4 rows, place the dropped st back on the needle and knit it tog with the 4 unraveled strands, p5; rep from * to last st, k1.

Row 6 (WS): [P1, k5] to last st, p1.

Belleview Stitch (in the round)

Worked over 6 sts

Rounds 1-4: [K1, p5] to end. **Round 5:** *Drop the next knit st from the LH needle and unravel 4 rows, place the dropped st back on the needle and knit it tog with the 4 unraveled strands, p5; rep from * to end. **Round 6:** [K1, p5] to end.

1x1 Rib (flat)
Worked over an odd number of sts
Row 1 (RS): K1, [p1, k1] to end.
Row 2 (WS): P1, [k1, p1] to end.
Rep rows 1-2 for patt.

1x1 Rib (in the round)Worked over an even number of stsRound 1: [K1, p1] to end.Rep round 1 for patt.

PATTERN BEGINS

BODY

Hem

Using the Cable Cast-On method, cast on 159 (183, 195, 219, 231, 255, 279, 291, 315, 327) sts. **Row 1 (RS):** K2, [p1, k1] to last st, k1. **Row 2 (WS):** K1, [p1, k1] to last 2 sts, p1, k1. Rep rows 1-2 until hem measures approx. 2.5cm / 1" from cast-on edge.

Row 1 (RS): K2, [p5, k1] to last st, k1. Row 2 (WS): K1, [p1, k5] to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rows 3-4: Rep rows 1-2.

Row 5: K1, *drop the next st from the LH needle and unravel 4 rows, place the dropped st back on the needle and knit it tog with the 4 unraveled strands, p5; rep from * to last 2 sts, drop the next st from the LH needle and unravel 4 rows, place the dropped st back on the needle and knit it tog with the 4 unraveled strands, k1.

Row 6: K1, [p1, k5] to last 2 sts, p1, k1.

Rep rows 1-6 until body measures approx. 25cm /10" from cast-on edge or desired length to underarm, ending with row 6.

Separating the Fronts and Back

Set-up row (RS): K1, work in patt across 36 (42, 46, 52, 56, 60, 68, 70, 76, 78) sts for right front, cast off next 6 (6, 3, 3, 3, 6, 3, 3, 3, 6) sts, work in patt across next 73 (85, 95, 107, 111, 121, 135, 143, 155, 157) sts for back, cast off next 6 (6, 3, 3, 3, 6, 3, 3, 6) sts, work in patt to last st, k1. *147 (171, 189, 213, 225, 243, 273, 285, 309, 315) sts*

Note: To give a neat edge for sewing in the sleeves, the first and last st of each front and back panel will now be worked as a knit stitch, regardless of whether it was a purl or a dropped st on previous rows.

Next row (WS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1 and turn, placing rem back and right front sts on hold. 37 (43, 47, 53, 57, 61, 69, 71, 77, 79) sts Work each front and back separately, beginning with left front.

LEFT FRONT

Note: Maintain established Belleview Stitch patt throughout. Decreases are worked on RS rows only. When decreasing, p2tog when the next 2 sts are purl sts or if the first st is a knit st followed by a purl st; if the second st is a knit, k2tog and work this st as instructed in patt for knit sts, all along the following rows.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1.
Row 2 (WS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1.
Rows 3-4: Rep rows 1-2.
Row 5 (dec): K1, p2tog or k2tog (see Note above), work in patt to last st, k1. 1 st dec
Row 6: K1, work in patt to last st, k1.
Rep rows 3-6 a further 0 (0, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 0) times. 36 (42, 45, 51, 55, 59, 67, 69, 75, 78) sts

Work straight in patt (maintaining knitted edge sts) until left front measures approx. 17 (17, 17, 18, 18, 19, 19, 20, 20, 21) cm / $6\frac{3}{4}$ ($6\frac{3}{4}$, $6\frac{3}{4}$, $7\frac{1}{4}$, $7\frac{1}{4}$, $7\frac{1}{2}$, $7\frac{1}{2}$, 8, 8, $8\frac{1}{4}$)" from underarm, ending with row 6 of Belleview Stitch pattern.

Left Front Neck

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in patt to end, k1.Row 2 (WS)(dec): Cast off 5 sts, work in patt to last st, k1.

Rep rows 1-2 a further 2 (3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 5, 5, 6, 6) times. 21 (22, 25, 31, 35, 34, 37, 39, 40, 43) sts

Next row (RS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1. **Next row (WS):** Cast off 1 (2, 5, 1, 5, 4, 2, 4, 0, 3) sts, work in patt to last st, k1. 20 (20, 20, 30, 30, 30, 35, 35, 40, 40) sts

Work straight in patt until left front measures approx. 20 (21, 22, 22, 23, 23, 23, 25, 25, 26)cm / 8 (8¹/₄, 8³/₄, 8³/₄, 9, 9, 9, 10, 10, 10¹/₄)" from underarm, ending with row 6 of Belleview Stitch pattern.

Left Front Shoulder

Row 1 (RS)(dec): Cast off 5 sts, work in patt to last st, k1. **Row 2 (WS):** K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Rep rows 1-2 until 5 sts rem. Cast off rem sts.

BACK

Note: Maintain established Belleview Stitch patt throughout. Decreases are worked on RS rows only. When decreasing, p2tog when the next 2 sts are purl sts or if the first st is a knit st followed by a purl st; if the second st is a knit, k2tog and work this st as instructed in patt for knit sts, all along the following rows.

With WS facing, rejoin yarn to 73 (85, 95, 107, 111, 121, 135, 143, 155, 157) held back sts. **Next row (WS):** K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Row 1 (RS): K1, p2tog or k2tog (see Note above), work in patt to last 3 sts, p2tog or k2tog, k1. 2 sts dec

Row 2 (WS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Rep rows 1-2 a further 1 (1, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 2, 1) times. 69 (81, 89, 101, 105, 115, 129, 137, 149, 153) sts

Work straight in patt (maintaining knitted edge sts) until back measures approx. 20 (21, 22, 22, 23, 23, 23, 25, 25, 26) cm / 8 (8¹/₄, 8³/₄, 8³/₄, 9,9, 9, 10, 10, 10¹/₄)" from underarm, ending with row 6 of Belleview Stitch pattern.

Back Left Shoulder

Row 1 (RS): Cast off 5 sts, work in patt until there are 17 (17, 17, 27, 27, 27, 32, 32, 37, 37) sts on RH needle and place these sts on hold, cast off next 25 (37, 45, 37, 41, 51, 55, 63, 65, 69) sts for back neck, work in patt to last st, k1. 22 (22, 22, 32, 32, 32, 37, 37, 42, 42) sts Work each shoulder separately.

Row 2 (WS-dec): Cast off 5 sts, work in patt to last st, k1.
Row 3: K1, p2tog or k2tog, work in patt to last st, k1. 1 st dec
Rows 4-5: Rep rows 2-3. 10 (10, 10, 20, 20, 20, 25, 25, 30, 30) sts
Row 6: Cast off 5 sts, work in patt to last st, k1.
Row 7: K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Rep rows 6-7 until 5 sts rem. Cast off rem sts.

Back Right Shoulder

With WS facing, rejoin yarn to 17 (17, 17, 27, 27, 27, 32, 32, 37, 37) held back right shoulder sts. **Row 1 (WS)(dec):** K1, k2tog or p2tog, work in patt to last st, k1. 16 (16, 16, 26, 26, 26, 31, 31, 36, 36) sts

Row 2 (RS-dec): Cast off 5 sts, work in patt to last st, k1. 11 (11, 11, 21, 21, 21, 26, 26, 31, 31) sts **Row 3 (dec):** K1, k2tog or p2tog, work in patt to last st, k1. 10 (10, 10, 20, 20, 20, 25, 25, 30, 30) sts

Row 4: Cast off 5 sts, work in patt to last st, k1.

Row 5: K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Rep rows 4-5 until 5 sts rem.

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Cast off rem sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Note: Maintain established Belleview Stitch patt throughout. Decreases are worked on RS rows only. When decreasing, p2tog when the next 2 sts are purl sts or if the first st is a knit st followed by a purl st; if the second st is a knit, k2tog and work this st as instructed in patt for knit sts, all along the following rows.

With WS facing, rejoin yarn to 37 (43, 47, 53, 57, 61, 69, 71, 77, 79) held right front sts. Set-up row (WS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1. Row 2 (WS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1. Rows 3-4: Rep rows 1-2. Row 5 (dec): K1, work in patt to last 3 sts, p2tog or k2tog, k1. 1 st dec Row 6: K1, work in patt to last st, k1. Rep rows 3-6 a further 0 (0, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 0) times. 36 (42, 45, 51, 55, 59, 67, 69, 75, 78) sts

Work straight in patt (maintaining knitted edge sts) until right front measures approx. 17 (17, 17, 18, 18, 19, 19, 20, 20, 21)cm / 6³/₄ (6³/₄, 6³/₄, 7¹/₄, 7¹/₄, 7¹/₂, 7¹/₂, 8, 8, 8¹/₄)" from underarm, ending with row 6 of Belleview Stitch pattern.

Right Front Neck

Row 1 (RS)(dec): Cast off 5 sts, work in patt to last st, k1. Row 2 (WS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Rep rows 1-2 a further 2 (3, 3, 3, 3, 4, 5, 5, 6, 6) times. 21 (22, 25, 31, 35, 34, 37, 39, 40, 43) sts

Next row (RS): Cast off 1 (2, 5, 1, 5, 4, 2, 4, 0, 3) sts, work in patt to last st, k1. 20 (20, 20, 30, 30, 30, 35, 35, 40, 40) sts **Next row (WS):** K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Work straight in patt until right front measures approx. 20 (21, 22, 22, 23, 23, 23, 25, 25, 26) cm / 8 (8¹/4, 8³/4, 8³/4, 9, 9, 9, 10, 10, 10¹/4)" from underarm, ending with row 6 of Belleview Stitch pattern.

Right Front Shoulder

Row 1 (WS)(dec): Cast off 5 sts, work in patt to last st, k1. Row 2 (RS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1. Rep rows 1-2 until 5 sts rem. Cast off rem sts.

Join shoulders

With RS facing, pick up 20 (20, 20, 30, 30, 30, 35, 35, 40, 40) sts along each front and back shoulder edge.

With RS together, join shoulders using a three-needle cast-off.

SLEEVES (both alike)

Cast on 54 (60, 60, 66, 72, 84, 90, 96, 102, 108) sts, join to work in the round being careful not to twist sts and PM for beg of round.

Round 1: [K1, p1] to end.

Rep round 1 until cuff measures approx. 2.5cm / 1" from cast-on edge.

Work Belleview Stitch pattern in the round until sleeve measures 10cm / 4" from cast-on edge or desired length, ending with round 6 of patt.

Sleeve Cap

Note: Maintain established Belleview Stitch patt throughout. Decreases are worked on RS rows only. When decreasing, p2tog when the next 2 sts are purl sts or if the first st is a knit st followed by a purl st; if the second st is a knit, k2tog and work this st as instructed in patt for knit sts, all along the following rows

Set-up round: Work in patt to last 6 (6, 3, 3, 3, 6, 3, 3, 6, 3, 3, 6) sts, cast off next 6 (6, 3, 3, 3, 6, 3, 3, 6) sts (removing marker), work in patt to last st, k1. 48 (54, 57, 63, 69, 78, 87, 93, 99, 102) sts Break yarn and rejoin in order to start the next row with RS facing.

Row 1 (RS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1.
Row 2 (WS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1.
Rows 3-4: Rep rows 1-2.
Row 5 (dec): K1, p2tog or k2tog, work in patt to last 3 sts, p2tog or k2tog, k1. 2 sts dec
Row 6 (WS): K1, work in patt to last st, k1.

Rep rows 3-6 a further 0 (0, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) times. 46 (52, 53, 59, 65, 74, 83, 89, 95, 100) sts

Work 6 rows straight in pattern as established, maintaining knitted edge sts. Maintaining established pattern, cast off 2 sts at beg of next 18 (20, 20, 24, 26, 32, 36, 38, 42, 44) rows. 10 (12, 13, 11, 13, 10, 11, 13, 11, 12) sts Cast off rem sts.

RIGHT BUTTON BAND

With RS facing, beg at bottom corner, pick up and knit 81 (81, 81, 81, 83, 83, 85, 85, 87, 87, 89) sts evenly along right front edge (approx. 1 st per 2 rows).

Next row (WS): [P1, k1] to last st, p1.
Row 1 (RS): [K1, p1] to last st, k1.
Row 2 (WS): [P1, k1] to last st, p1.
Rep rows 1-2 until button band measures approx. 2.5 cm / 1" from pick-up row or desired length, ending with a WS row. Cast off using the Italian cast-off method.

LEFT BUTTON BAND

With RS facing, beg at top corner, pick up and knit 81 (81, 81, 81, 83, 83, 85, 85, 87, 87, 89) sts evenly along left front edge (approx. 1 st per 2 rows).

Next row (WS): [P1, k1] to last st, p1. Last row establishes 1x1 Rib patt.

Buttonholes

Next row (RS): Work 4 (4, 4, 2, 2, 3, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts in patt, k2tog or p2tog to maintain 1x1 rib, yo, *work 8 (8, 8, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9, 9) sts in patt, k2tog or p2tog, yo; rep from * to last 5 (5, 5, 2, 2, 3, 3, 4, 4, 5) sts, work in patt to end.

Row 1 (RS): [K1, p1] to last st, k1.

Row 2 (WS): [P1, k1] to last st, p1.

Rep rows 1-2 until button band measures approx. 2.5 cm / 1" from pick-up row or desired length, ending with a WS row.

Cast off using the Italian cast-off method.

COLLAR

With RS facing, beg at top corner of right button band, pick up and knit 5 sts along top edge of button band, pick up and knit 26 (32, 35, 31, 35, 39, 42, 44, 45, 48) sts evenly along right front neck, pick up and knit 2 sts at the shoulder seam, pick up and knit 37 (49, 57, 49, 53, 63, 67, 75, 77, 81) sts evenly along back neck, pick up and knit 2 sts at the shoulder seam, pick up and knit 26 (32, 35, 31, 35, 39, 42, 44, 45, 48) sts evenly along left front neck, pick up and knit 5 sts along button band. *103 (127, 141, 125, 137, 155, 165, 177, 181, 191) sts*

Next row (WS): [P1, k1] to last st, p1 Row 1 (RS): [K1, p1] to last st, k1. Row 2 (WS): [P1, k1] to last st, p1. Row 3: [K1, p1] to last 5 sts, k1, p2tog, yo, p1, k1. Row 4: [P1, k1] to last st, p1.


Rep rows 1-2 until collar measures approx. 2.5 cm / 1" from pick-up row or desired length, ending with a WS row. Cast off using the Italian cast-off method.

FINISHING

With RS together, pin the sleeves to the body and sew them into the armholes using a tapestry needle and back stitch. Sew buttons onto button band to match buttonholes. Weave in ends and block to measurements.

e. Sleeve length (cuff to underarm): 10cm / 4"
