KNITTING PATTERN

Gumnut Cabled Hat

Design: Vera Marcu | Winter 2025



MATERIALS

Pom Pom x Hobbii Garland **Shade:** Tadpole (12); 2 balls

4.5mm / US 7 circular needle, 40cm / 16" length

4.5mm / US 7 needles suitable for working small circumferences in the round

Always use a needle size that will result in the correct gauge after blocking.

3 stitch markers (including one unique for beg of round), cable needle, tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Garland, Hobbii x Pom Pom Worsted weight 70% Cotton, 30% Alpaca 105m / 114yd per 50 g

GAUGE

22 sts & 30 rows = 10cm / 4" over 2/2 Rib on 4.5mm needles after blocking.

SIZES

1 (2, 3)

MEASUREMENTS

To fit approx. head circumference: 48 (54, 59)cm / 19 (211/4, 231/4)"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Gumnut Hat is worked in the round from the brim up.

ABBREVIATIONS

Beg: beginning Dec: decrease

Foll: follow(s)/following

K: knit

k2tog: knit 2 stitches together

LH: left hand

Patt: pattern (i.e. work in pattern)

PM: place marker

P: purl

Rem: remain(s)/remaining

Rep: repeat RH: right hand RS: right side

SI: slip

Ssk: slip 2 stitches knitwise one at a time, knit together through the back loops

SM: slip marker St(s): stitch(es)

St st: stocking stitch (stockinette): knit on RS rows, purl on WS rows

Tog: together WS: wrong side

STITCH GLOSSARY

2/2 Rib (in the round): Round 1: [K2, p2] to end.
Rep round 1 for pattern.

2/2 LC SI 2 sts to cable needle, hold at front, k2, k2 from cable needle
2/2 RC SI 2 sts to cable needle, hold at back, k2, k2 from cable needle
2/2 LPC SI 2 sts to cable needle, hold at front, p2, k2 from cable needle
2/2 RPC SI 2 sts to cable needle, hold at back, k2, p2 from cable needle



2/2/2 RPC SI 4 sts to cable needle, hold at back, k2, sI 2 sts from cable needle back to LH needle, p2, k2 from cable needle

WRITTEN INSTRUCTIONS FOR CHART

Round 1: 2/2 LC, [k2, p2] 3 times, k2, 2/2 RC.

Round 2: K6, [p2, k2] twice, p2, k6.

Round 3: K2, 2/2 LPC, p2, 2/2/2 RPC, p2, 2/2 RPC, k2.

Round 4: [K2, p2] 5 times, k2.

Round 5: K2, p2, 2/2 LC, k2, p2, k2, 2/2 RC, p2, k2.

Round 6: K2, [p2, k6] twice, p2, k2.

Round 7: K2, p2, k2, 2/2 LPC, p2, 2/2 RPC, k2, p2, k2.

Rounds 8-10: [K2, p2] 5 times, k2.

Round 11: K2, p2, 2/2 LC, k2, p2, k2, 2/2 RC, p2, k2.

Round 12: Rep round 6.

Round 13: K2, p2, k2, 2/2 LPC, p2, 2/2 RPC, k2, p2, k2.

Round 14: Rep round 4.

Round 15: [K2, p2] twice, 2/2/2 RPC, [p2, k2] twice.

Rounds 16-22: [K2, p2] 5 times, k2.

Round 23: Rep round 15.

PATTERN BEGINS

Using the long-tail method, cast on 84 (96, 108) sts. PM and join for working in the round, being careful not to twist stitches.

Brim

Rounds 1-20 (RS): Work 2/2 Rib to end.

Round 21: *Work 28 (32, 36) sts in patt, PM; rep from * once, work in patt to end.

Body

Round 1: *Work round 1 of chart, p2, [k2, p2] to marker, SM; rep from * to end.

Round 2-23: Working next round of chart each time, continue in patt as set until round 23 of chart is complete.

Round 24: *[K2, p2] to marker, remove marker; rep from * to end, removing beg of round marker after final rep.

Crown

Note: As the number of stitches decreases, change to needles suitable for small circumferences when it becomes necessary.

Set-up round: [K2, p2] twice, k2, p1, PM for new beg of round, p1, [k2, p2] to last 3 sts, k2, p1.

Size 2 ONLY:

Round 1: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k1, ssk, k2tog, k1, [p2, k2] 3 times, p1; rep from * to end. 90 sts

Round 2: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k4, [p2, k2] 3 times, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 3: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k2tog, ssk, [p2, k2] 3 times, p1; rep from * to end. 84 sts

Round 4: *P1, [k2, p2] 6 times, k2, p1; rep from * to end.



Size 3 ONLY:

Round 1: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k2, p1, k2tog, ssk, p1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 102 sts

Round 2: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, [k2, p1] twice, [k2, p2] 3 times, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 3: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k2, k2tog, ssk, [k2, p2] 3 times, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 96 sts

Round 4: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k6, [p2, k2] 3 times, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 5: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k1, k2tog, ssk, k1, [p2, k2] 3 times, p1; rep from * to end. 90 sts

Round 6: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k4, [p2, k2] 3 times, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 7: *P1, [k2, p2] 3 times, k2tog, ssk, [p2, k2] 3 times, p1; rep from * to end. 84 sts

Round 8: *P1, [k2, p2] 6 times, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

ALL sizes again:

Round 1: *P1, [k2, p2] twice, k2, p1, k2tog, ssk, p1, [k2, p2] twice, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 78 sts

Round 2: *P1, [k2, p2] twice, [k2, p1] twice, [k2, p2] twice, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 3: *P1, [k2, p2] twice, k2, k2tog, ssk, [k2, p2] twice, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 72 sts

Round 4: *P1, [k2, p2] twice, k6, [p2, k2] twice, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 5: *P1, [k2, p2] twice, k1, k2tog, ssk, k1, [p2, k2] twice, p1; rep from * to end. 66 sts

Round 6: *P1, [k2, p2] twice, k4, [p2, k2] twice, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 7: *P1, [k2, p2] twice, k2tog, ssk, [p2, k2] twice, p1; rep from * to end. 60 sts

Round 8: *P1, [k2, p2] 4 times, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 9: *P1, k2, p2, k2, p1, k2tog, ssk, p1, k2, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 54 sts

Round 10: *P1, k2, p2, [k2, p1] twice, k2, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 11: *P1, k2, p2, k2, k2tog, ssk, k2, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 48 sts

Round 12: *P1, k2, p2, k6, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 13: *P1, k2, p2, k1, k2tog, ssk, k1, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 42 sts

Round 14: *P1, k2, p2, k4, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 15: *P1, k2, p2, k2tog, ssk, p2, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 36 sts

Round 16: *P1, [k2, p2] twice, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 17: *P1, k2, p1, k2tog, ssk, p1, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 30 sts

Round 18: *P1, [k2, p1] 3 times; rep from * to end.

Round 19: *P1, k2, k2tog, ssk, k2, p1; rep from * to end. 24 sts

Round 20: *P1, k6, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 21: *P1, k1, k2tog, ssk, k1, p1; rep from * to end. 18 sts

Round 22: *P1, k4, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 23: *P1, k2tog, ssk, p1; rep from * to end. 12 sts

Round 24: *P1, k2, p1; rep from * to end.

Round 25: *K2tog, ssk; rep from * to end. 6 sts

Round 26: K6.

Break yarn, leaving a long tail. Thread tail through rem sts and pull tight to close hole.


FINISHING

Weave in all ends and wet block to measurements, drying flat or over an inflated balloon.

SCHEMATIC




a. Brim circumference (unstretched): 38 (44, 49)cm / 15 (171/4, 191/4)"
