Topaz

Shawl

MATERIALS

3 skeins of **Rainbow Bamboo** color 21

Circular needle 3.75 mm, 80 cm /US 5, 32"

Stitch markers

Blocking wires & t-pins (optional)

YARN QUALITY

 **Rainbow Bamboo**, Hobbii

60 % Bamboo viscose, 40 % Cotton

100 g / 3.5 oz = 250 m / 274 yds

GAUGE

18 sts x 36 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

CO = Cast on

K = Knit

K2tog = Knit 2 stitches together

K2tog-tbl = Knit 2 stitches together through the back loop

LH = Left hand

P = Purl

Pm = Place marker

Rep = Repeat

RH = Right hand

RS = Right side

Sm = Slip marker

Ssk = Slip, slip, knit; slip 2 stitches one at a time knitwise to the right-hand needle; insert the left-hand needle into the fronts of these 2 stitches and knit them together

St(s) = Stitch(es)

WS = Wrong side

Yo = Yarnover

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Wingspan: 188 cm / 74"

Center Depth: 46 cm / 18"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This crescent shawl is the perfect project for adventurous beginners looking to dip their toes into lace knitting or for experienced knitters seeking a relaxing, meditative knit. Worked from the top down, the shawl's crescent shape is achieved through yarnover increases on both the right and wrong sides. The modern zigzag lace pattern is created using simple yarnovers and decreases, making it both engaging and approachable. Finished with a stretchy bind-off, this shawl drapes beautifully and adds a touch of sophistication to any outfit. Whether you're looking to expand your skills or enjoy a peaceful knitting experience, this shawl is a delightful project to add to your collection.

CAST ON

Set-up

CO 6 sts onto circular needle using the Long-Tail Cast On Method.

Set-up row: K2, pm, yo, k2, yo, pm, k2. [8 sts]

WORK LACE PATTERN

Rows 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, & 11 (WS): K2, sm, yo, k1, p to 1 st before next m, k1, yo, sm, k2. [2 sts increased]

Rows 2, 4, & 6 (RS): K2, sm, yo, k1, *yo, k2tog, repeat from * to 1 st before next m, k1, yo, sm, k2. [2 sts increased]

Rows 8, 10, & 12 (RS): K2, sm, yo, k1, *ssk, yo, repeat from * to 1 st before next m, k1, yo, sm, k2. [2 sts increased]

Continue in pattern, repeating Rows 1 - 12 until piece measures approximately 46 cm / 18" at the center, measured from top cast-on edge to bottom, ending with Row 1.

BIND OFF

Bind Off Row (RS): K2, sl 2 sts from RH needle back to LH needle, *k2tog-tbl, sl st from RH needle back to LH needle, rep from * until 1 st remains. Break yarn and pull tail through last st.

WET BLOCK

Weave in all ends. Wash the entire shawl, allowing it to soak a minimum of 45 minutes in lukewarm water with wool wash. Gently remove excess water by rolling it between two thick towels. Pin and shape shawl to measurements, (using blocking wires for best results), and allow to dry completely.
