MATERIALS

Portobello

A: 9 (11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 18, 20, 21) skeins of color 20

B: 1 skein of color 4 C: 1 skein of color 9 D: 1 skein of color 10 E: 1 skein of color 17

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8 for ribbing Crochet hook 6 mm / US J/10 Tapestry needle Stitch markers

YARN QUALITY

Portobello, Hobbii
60% Cotton, 28% Acrylic, 12% Wool
50 g (1.75 oz) = 120 m (131 yds)

GAUGE

 $13 dc \times 8 rows = 10 cm \times 10 cm / 4" \times 4"$

MEASUREMENTS

Chest circumference: 87.5 (104, 119.5, 134.5, 151, 166.5, 181.5, 198, 213.5) cm / 34.5 (41, 47, 53, 59.5, 65.5, 71.5, 78, 84)"

Length (shoulder to hem): 51 (53.5, 56, 59.5, 59.5, 59.5, 59.5, 62, 62) cm / 20 (21, 22, 23.5, 23.5, 23.5, 23.5, 24.5, 24.5)"

Upper Sleeve circumference: 35.5 (39.5, 40.5, 43, 44.5, 47.5, 53.5, 54.5, 56) cm / 14 (15.5, 16, 17, 17.5, 18.75, 21, 21.5, 22)"

Sleeve length: 57 (60.5, 65, 65, 65, 66, 66, 66) cm / 22.5 (23.75, 25.5, 25.5, 25.5, 25.5, 26, 26, 26)"

Suggested positive ease: 10-15 cm / 4-6" The chest measurements given are the finished measurements, so you should choose a finished size that is 10-15 cm / 4-6" larger than your chest measurement.

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Crocheted Braided Horizon Hoodie is a unisex sweater that combines classic comfort with artisanal charm. Stitched from a warm yet breathable wool and cotton blend, this lightweight hoodie keeps you cozy without overheating, making it perfect for cool autumn days or chilly winter evenings. The unique braided rows that travel up the front create texture, while the hood elevates its cozy appeal. This sweater designed by Jonah's Hands is as much a statement piece as it is a wardrobe essential.

Back and front are worked flat and sewn together. Sleeves are worked in joined rows and seamed to the armhole.

ABBREVIATIONS

beg = beginning

blo = back loop only

ch = chain

dc = double crochet

hdc = half double crochet

rep = repeat

RS = right side of work

sc = single crochet

sc2tog = single crochet 2 sts together

sk = skip stitch

sl st = slip stitch

st(s) = stitch(es)

WS = wrong side of work

yo = yarn over

INFO AND TIPS

US crochet terms used throughout.

Turn at the end of each row unless otherwise specified.

Sc2tog: Insert hook into st and draw up a loop, insert hook into next st and draw up a loop, yarn over and draw through 3 loops.

Hdc Ribbing

Ch desired number of sts.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc blo in 2nd loop from hook, hdc blo to end, turn.

Row 2: Ch1 (does not count as a st), hdc blo in each st to end, turn.

Rep Row 2 for desired number of rows.

BACK

Ribbing

With 5 mm / US H/8 crochet hook and yarn A, ch9.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc blo in 2nd loop from hook, hdc blo to end, turn. 8 hdc

Row 2: Ch1 (does not count as a st), hdc blo in each st to end, turn.



Rep Row 2 until there are a total of 38 (46, 52, 58, 66, 72, 78, 86, 92) rows, ending after a WS row.

Back Body

Next Row (RS): Turn. Ch1, hdc blo to end, ch1 (counts as hdc), turn piece 90 degrees to the right, (hdc in side of row, hdc in top of V st, hdc in side of row) to end, working last hdc into beg ch of ribbing. 57 (69, 78, 87, 99, 108, 117, 129, 138) sts.

Change to 6 mm / US J/10 crochet hook.

Next Row: Ch3 (counts as dc throughout), work dc in each st to end.

Rep last row until there are 35 (37, 39, 41, 41, 41, 41, 43, 43) dc rows. Fasten off.







FRONT

Ribbing

With 5 mm / US H/8 crochet hook and yarn A, ch9.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc blo in 2nd loop from hook, hdc blo to end, turn. 8 hdc

Row 2: Ch1 (does not count as a st), hdc blo in each st to end, turn.

Rep Row 2 until there are a total of 36 (44, 50, 56, 62, 70, 76, 82, 90) rows, ending after a WS row. Do not turn.

Front Body

Next Row (WS): With WS facing at the end of a ribbing row, ch1 (does not count as a st), (hdc in side of row, hdc in top of V st, hdc in side of row) to end, adjusting as needed to reach the total st count. 55 (65, 75, 85, 95, 105, 115, 125, 135) sts.

Stripes and Loops

Note: Carry unused colors up the side if desired.

Change to 6 mm / US J/10 crochet hook.

Loop Row (RS): Ch3 (counts as dc throughout), 4dc, [ch10, sl st in the top of the same dc, 5dc] to end. 10 (12, 14, 16, 18, 20, 22, 24, 26) loop columns.

Change to color B.

Next Row (WS): Ch1 (does not count as a st), hdc to end.

Next Row (RS): Work Loop Row.

Last 2 rows set Loop Row stripe. Repeat the last 2 rows once each with colors C, D, and E. 5 loop rows completed.



Continue working in the established pattern with colors A, B, C, D and E until there are a total of 20 (22, 23, 25, 25, 25, 25, 26, 26) loop rows worked.

Next row (WS): Using the next color in the stripe sequence, ch1, hdc to end.







UPPER LEFT FRONT

Maintain stripe pattern as established.

Next Row (RS): Ch3, 4dc, [ch10, sl st in the top of the same dc, 5dc] 4 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12) times, turn. Do not work the last loop at the neck edge. 25 (30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65) sts.

Braid the column of loops closest to the neck edge by drawing the second loop through the bottom-most loop, and continuing up the column pulling each loop through the previous one.

Next Row (WS): Change colors, ch1, sc into top of loop from braided column, sk 1 dc, hdc to end.

Next Row (RS): Work Loop Row over 25 (30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65) sts. Work 2 more Loop Row stripes as established. 24 (26, 27, 29, 29, 29, 30, 30) stripes total.

Left Shoulder

Braid up all remaining columns of loops on the left side of the body, drawing each loop through the one below it, until you reach the top of the shoulder. Change colors for the final stripe.

Next Row (WS): Ch1, hdc to end.

Next Row (RS): Ch3, 3dc, [2sc in top of loop, sk 2 hdc, 3dc] to end, dc in last st.

Fasten off.















UPPER RIGHT FRONT

Maintain stripe pattern as established.

With RS facing, skip 5 sts in centre of body, join yarn to continue pattern.

Next Row (RS): Ch3, 4dc, [ch10, sl st in the top of the same dc, 5dc] 4 (5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12) times, turn. 25 (30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65) sts.

Braid the column of loops closest to the neck edge by drawing the second loop through the bottom-most loop, and continuing up the column pulling each loop through the previous one.

Next Row (WS): Change colors, ch1, hdc to last 2 sts, sc into top of loop from braided column, sk 1 dc, hdc in last st.

Next Row (RS): Work Loop Row over 25 (30, 35, 40, 45, 50, 55, 60, 65) sts. Work 2 more Loop Row stripes as established. 24 (26, 27, 29, 29, 29, 30, 30) stripes total.

Right Shoulder

Braid up all remaining columns of loops on the right side of the body, drawing each loop through the one below it, until you reach the top of the shoulder.

Change colors for the final stripe.

Next Row (WS): Ch1, hdc to end.

Next Row (RS): Ch3, 3dc, [2sc in top of loop, sk 2 hdc, 3dc] to end, dc in last st. Fasten off.









SLEEVES (both alike)

Note: After the cuff, the sleeves are worked in joined rows.

CUFF

With 5 mm / US H/8 crochet hook and yarn A, ch8.

Row 1 (RS): Hdc blo in 2nd loop from hook, hdc blo to end, turn. 7 hdc

Row 2: Ch1 (does not count as a st), hdc blo in each st to end, turn.

Rep Row 2 until there are a total of 20 (20, 20, 22, 22, 24, 24, 24) rows, ending after a WS row.

Next Row (RS): Turn. Ch1, hdc blo to end, ch1, turn piece 90 degrees to the right. (2hdc in side of st, 1 hdc in V rib) across ribbing, sl st into beg ch, turn. 30 (30, 30, 33, 33, 33, 36, 36, 36) sts

Change to 6 mm / US J/10 crochet hook.

Increase Row: Ch3 (counts as dc throughout), 2dc in next st, dc in each st to last st, 2dc in last st, sl st into beg ch, turn. 2 dc increased.

Working in dc as set, rep Increase Row every 3rd (3rd, 3rd, 3rd, 3rd, 2nd, 2nd, 2nd, 2nd, 2nd) row a further 7 (9, 10, 10, 11, 13, 15, 16, 17) times. 46 (50, 52, 55, 57, 61, 68, 70, 72) sts.

Work straight in dc a further 10 (6, 8, 8, 5, 13, 10, 8, 6) rows or until sleeve measures desired length. Fasten off.

Make second sleeve the same.

JOIN SHOULDERS

Working from shoulder edge towards center of body, join 13 (18, 21, 25, 29, 33, 37, 42, 45) sts from top of back to corresponding front shoulder with mattress stitch or slip stitch. Repeat for second shoulder.









HOOD

With WS facing and 6 mm / US J/10 crochet hook, join yarn A to Left Front neck edge.

Next Row (WS): Ch3 (counts as dc throughout), dc into 11 (11, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 17, 19) sts from Left Front, 31 (33, 36, 37, 41, 42, 43, 45, 48) sts from Back, and 12 (12, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18, 18, 20) sts from Right Front. 55 (57, 64, 67, 73, 76, 79, 81, 88) sts.

Sizes 3, 6, 9 only:

Next Row: Ch3, dc to center back neck, 2dc in same st, dc to end. - (-, 65, -, -, 77, -, -, 89) sts.

ALL sizes, Next Row: Ch3, dc in each st to end.

Rep last row until there are a total of 20 (22, 24, 24, 24, 26, 26, 26, 28) hood rows.

SHAPE HOOD

Next Row (WS): Ch3, dc next 23 (24, 28, 29, 32, 34, 35, 36, 40) sts, sc2tog, sc in next st and place marker into this st, sc2tog, dc to end. 2 sts decreased.

Dec Row: Ch3, work to 2 sts before marked st, sc2tog, sc in marked st, sc2tog, dc to end. 2 sts decreased.

Rep Dec Row a further 4 times. 45 (47, 55, 57, 63, 67, 69, 71, 79) sts

Join Hood

Fold hood in half with RS together. Join with slip stitch across top of hood. Fasten off.

Hood Edging

Using 5 mm / US H/8 crochet hook, Join yarn A to the front loop of the hdc at Right Front neck.

Set-up Row (RS): Ch1 (does not count as st throughout), (3sc in side of each pair of Loop Rows) 5 times, 2sc in side of each dc around edge of hood, (3sc in side of each pair of Loop Rows) 4 times at Left Front neck edge, 2sc in side of next row, sc in back loop of hdc at left side of neck.

Row 1 (WS): Ch1, sk 1 sc, sc in each st to end, sc in front loop of next hdc (from RS) at right side of neck.

Row 2 (RS): Ch1, sk 1 sc, sc in each st to end, sc in back loop of next hdc (from RS) at left side of neck.

Rep Rows 1-2 once more, working into subsequent unworked dc at center front, then work Row 1 once more.









FINISHING

Sew side seams.

Sew sleeves into armholes.

Beginning at the right shoulder seam, fold sc casing in half towards outside of hood and join with sl st to the left shoulder seam. Fasten off.

Crochet Cord

Using 5 mm / US H/8 crochet hook and yarn A or desired color, make a slipknot leaving a tail of at least 2m / 80".

Place slipknot on hook with tail end at front.

Make cord: *Bring tail over hook to the left of the loop on hook, yarn over with working yarn, draw working yarn through the 2 loops on hook. Repeat from * until cord measures approximately 95 (100, 105, 115, 125, 130, 135, 140, 145) cm / 37 (39, 42, 46, 50, 52, 54, 56, 58)" or desired length.

Thread cord through hood casing. Weave in remaining ends and block.
