## Sweater

## MATERIALS

### Dahlia Mixo

2, (2), 2, 3, 3 cakes of col. 11

### Friends Wheel

2, (2), 3, 3, 3 cakes of col. 77

Crochet hook 3 mm / US D/3

## YARN QUALITY

 **Dahlia Mixo**, Hobbii

100% Cotton

200 g (7.1 oz) = 800 m (875 yds)

 **Friends Wheel**, Hobbii

55% Cotton, 45% Acrylic

100 g (3.5 oz) = 400 m (437 yds)

## GAUGE

Square (5 rounds) = 11 cm x 11 cm / 4 ¼" x 4 ¼"

Square (4 rounds) = 8.5 cm x 8.5 cm / 3 ½" x 3 ½"

## ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

tc = treble crochet

puff st = puff stitch (Yarn over, insert hook into stitch, pull up a loop (3 loops on hook);

repeat [yarn over, insert hook, pull up a loop] 2 more times (7 loops on hook); yarn over, pull through all loops)

Rep = repeat

## SIZE

1, (2), 3, 4, 5

## MEASUREMENTS

Width: 45, (55), 60, 63, 66 cm / 17.75", 21.75", 23.5", 24.75", 26"

Length: 48, (58), 58, 58, 66 cm / 19", 22.75", 22.75", 26" *or preferred length*

Sleeve width: 18, (20), 22, 22, 27 cm / 7", 8", 8.75", 8.75", 10.5"

Sleeve length: 43, (57), 55, 57 cm / 17", 22.5", 21.75", 22.5" *or preferred length*

The sweater is meant to be worn with approx. 10-20 cm / 4-8" positive ease. Model is wearing size 2 with 20 cm / 8" positive ease.

## PATTERN INFORMATION

This pattern will guide you in creating a super lightweight sweater made from puff stitch squares, perfect for late spring and hot summer days.

# Pattern



## INFO AND TIPS

To crochet the sweater you will make either a 5-round square (green) or a 4-round square (violet) or a mix of both. The smaller motif has the same number of chain spaces as the larger one. See size charts on the last pages.

## SQUARE PATTERN

To make a 4-round square, crochet the first three rounds, skip the fourth round, change the yarn color, and crochet the fifth round. To make a 5-round square, simply crochet all the rounds.

With col. 11 ch 4, join with sl st to the first ch to form a circle.

Round 1 (col. 11): Ch 3, (puff st into the circle, ch 3) eight times, join with sl st to top of the first puff st. 8 puff stitches.

Round 2 (col. 11): Sl st in next ch-3 space, ch 3, puff st into the same space, ch 2, puff st in the same space, ch 2, (puff st in next ch-3 space, ch 2, puff st in same space, ch 2) 7 times, join with sl st to top of the first puff st. 16 puff stitches.

Round 3 (col. 11): Sl st in next ch-2 space, ch 3, puff st into the same space, ch 2, puff st in the same space, ch 2, puff st in next ch-2 space, ch 2, (puff st in next ch-2 space, ch 2, puff st in same space, ch 2, puff st in next ch-2 space, ch 2) 7 times, join with sl st to top of the first puff st. 24 puff stitches.

Round 4 (col. 11): Sl st in next ch-2 space, ch 3, puff st into the same space, ch 2, (puff st in next ch-2 space, ch 2) 23 times, join with sl st to top of the first puff st. 24 puff stitches.

Change the color of the yarn.

Round 5 (col. 77): Sl st in any ch-2 space, ch 4 (count as the first tc), 2 tc same space, ch 2, 3 tc in same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1) 5 times, \* 3 tc in next ch-2 space, ch 2, 3 tc in same space, ch 1, (3 dc in next ch-2 space, ch 1) 5 times \*\* rep from \* to \*\* twice, join with sl st to top of ch 4.



NOTE: You only need to complete the first square; the remaining squares will be joined one by one in the last round.

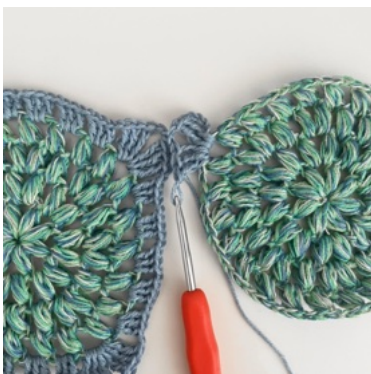
## JOINING

How to join 2 squares:

Round 5 (col. 77): Sl st in any ch-2 space of the second square, ch 4 (count as the first tc), 2 tc same space, sc in any ch-2 space of the first square, ch 1, 3 tc in same space of the second square,

sc in next ch-1 space of the first square, (3 dc in next ch-2 space of the second square, sc in next ch-1 space of the first square) 5 times,

3 tc in next ch-2 space of the second square, sc in next ch-2 space of the first square, ch 1, 3 tc in same space of the first square, finish the 5th round.

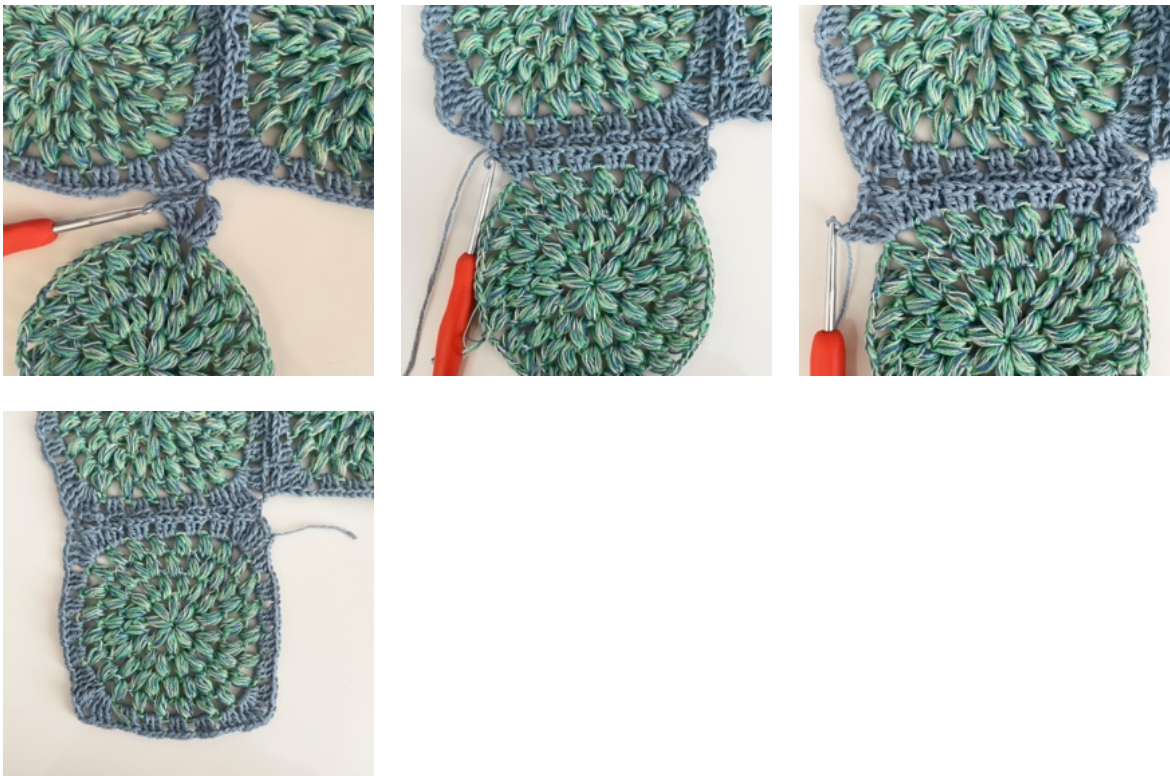


How to join 3 squares:

Round 5 (col. 77): Sl st in any ch-2 space of the third square, ch 4 (count as the first tc), 2 tc same space, sc in the right bottom ch-2 space of the first square, ch 1, 3 tc in same space of the third square,

sc in next ch-1 space of the first square, (3 dc in next ch-2 space of the third square, sc in next ch-1 space of the first square) 5 times,

3 tc in next ch-2 space of the third square, sc in next ch-2 space of the first square, ch 1, 3 tc in same space of the third square, finish the 5th round.



How to join 4 squares:

Round 5 (col. 77): Sl st in any ch-2 space of the fourth square, ch 4 (count as the first tc), 2 tc same space, sc in the right bottom ch-2 space of the second square, ch 1, 3 tc in same space of the fourth square,

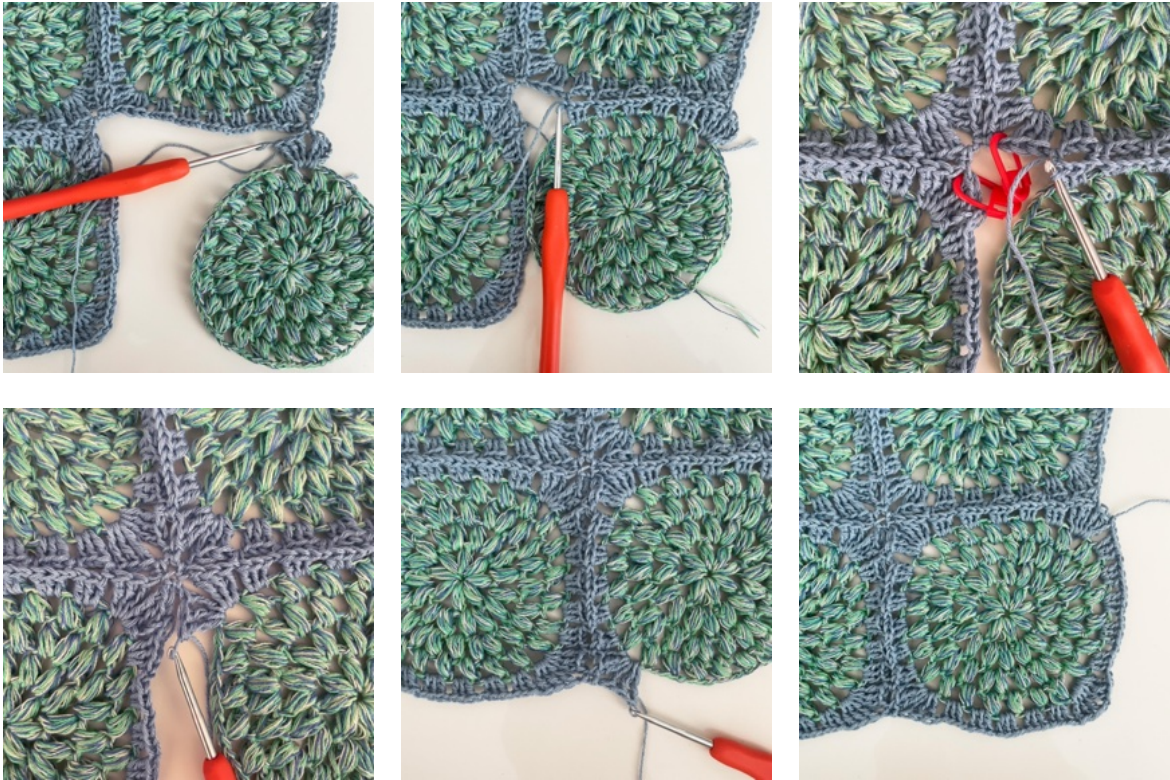
sc in next ch-1 space of the second square, (3 dc in next ch-2 space of the fourth square, sc in next ch-1 space of the second square) 5 times,

sc in next ch-2 space of the second square (marked red), sc in next ch-2 space of the third square,

3 tc in next ch-2 space of the fourth square, sc in next ch-2 space of the third square, ch 1, 3 tc in same space of the fourth square,

sc in next ch-1 space of the third square, (3 dc in next ch-2 space of the fourth square, sc in next ch-1 space of the third square) 5 times,

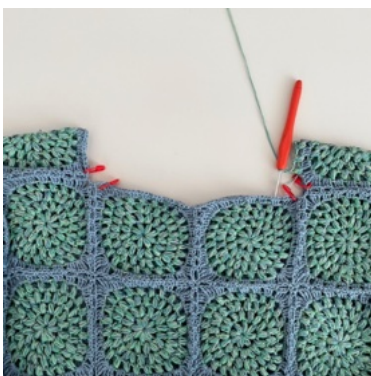
3 tc in next ch-2 space of the third square, sc in next ch-2 space of the third square, ch 1, 3 tc in same space of the fourth square, finish the 5th round.



Connect all the squares in the same way according to size charts (see the last pages of the pattern).

## NECKLINE

Round 1 (col. 11): Connect col to any ch-1 space, ch 3, puff st in same space, ch 2, \* puff st in next ch-1 space, ch 2 \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* around except the marked spaces (corners),



**How to crochet puffst2tog - 2 puff stitch together:**

work puff st in the first marked space, puff st in the second marked space, don't make any chain stitches between them, when you finish the second puff stitch crochet 2 chains. Work all 4 corners in this way. Join the round with sl st to top of the first puff st.



NOTE: if your neckline is narrow enough, don't crochet the second round, skip it and start with the third round.

Round 2 (col. 11): Sl st in next ch-2 space, ch 3, puff st in same space, ch 2, \* puff st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* around except the spaces before and after puffst2tog, in this spaces work puffst2tog, join with sl st to top of puff st.

Round 3-5 (col. 11): Sl st in next ch-2 space, ch 3, puff st in same space, ch 2, \* puff st in next ch-2 space, ch 2 \*\*, repeat from \* to \*\* around, join with sl st to top of puff st.

Round 6 (col. 77): Connect col to any ch-2 space, ch 3 (count as the first dc), 2 dc in same space, 3 dc in each ch-2 space around, join with sl st to top of ch 3.



Secure all ends. Your sweater is now ready :)

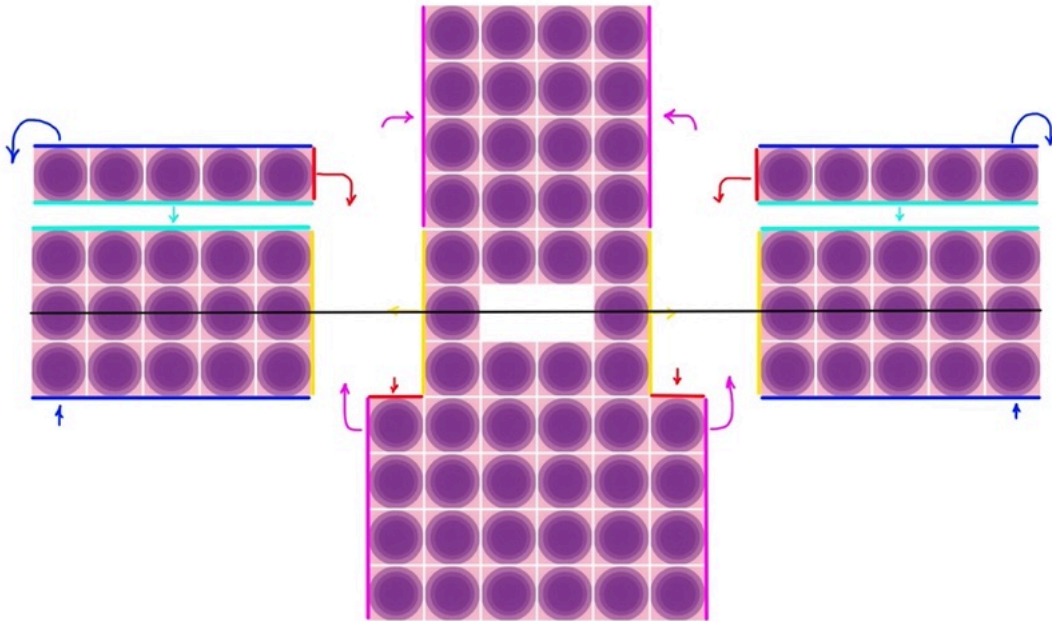

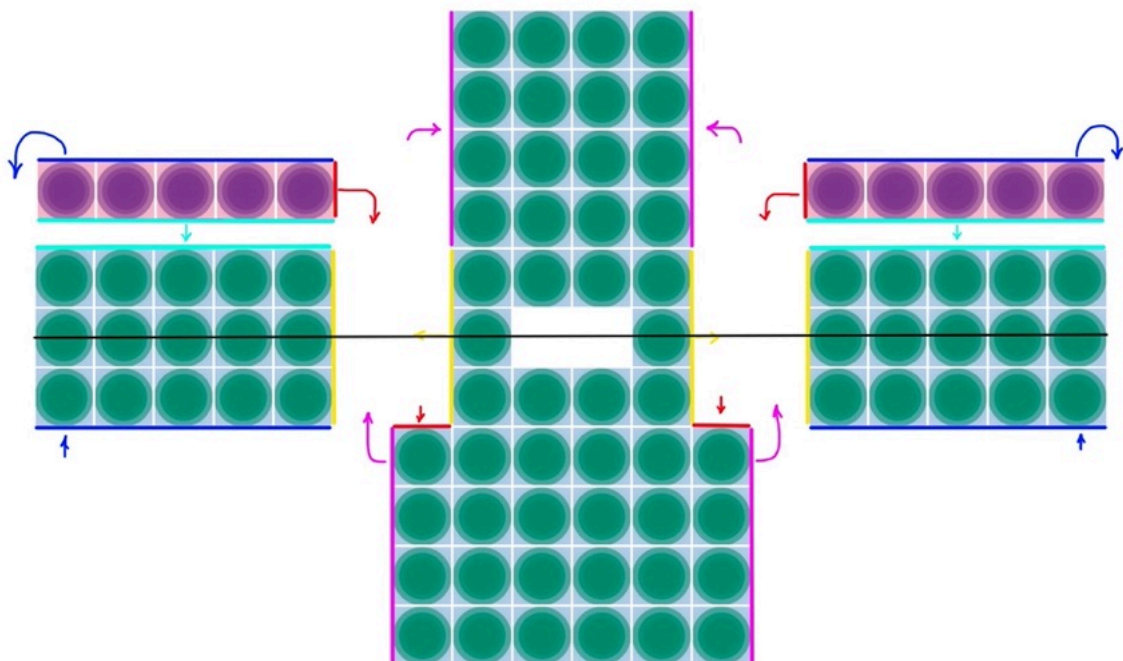
5-round square (green)

4-round square (violet)

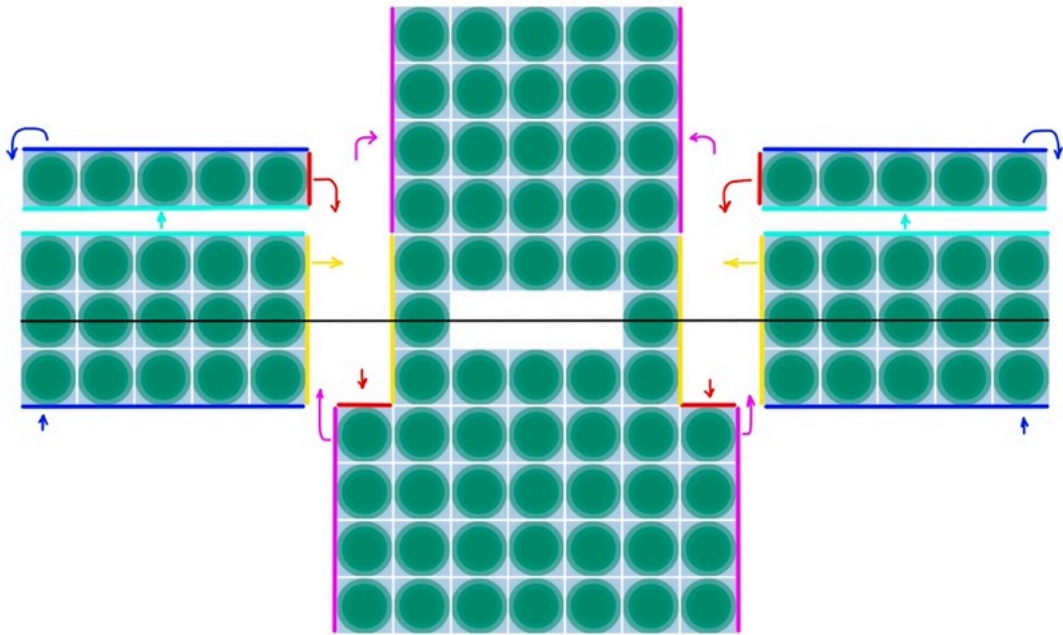

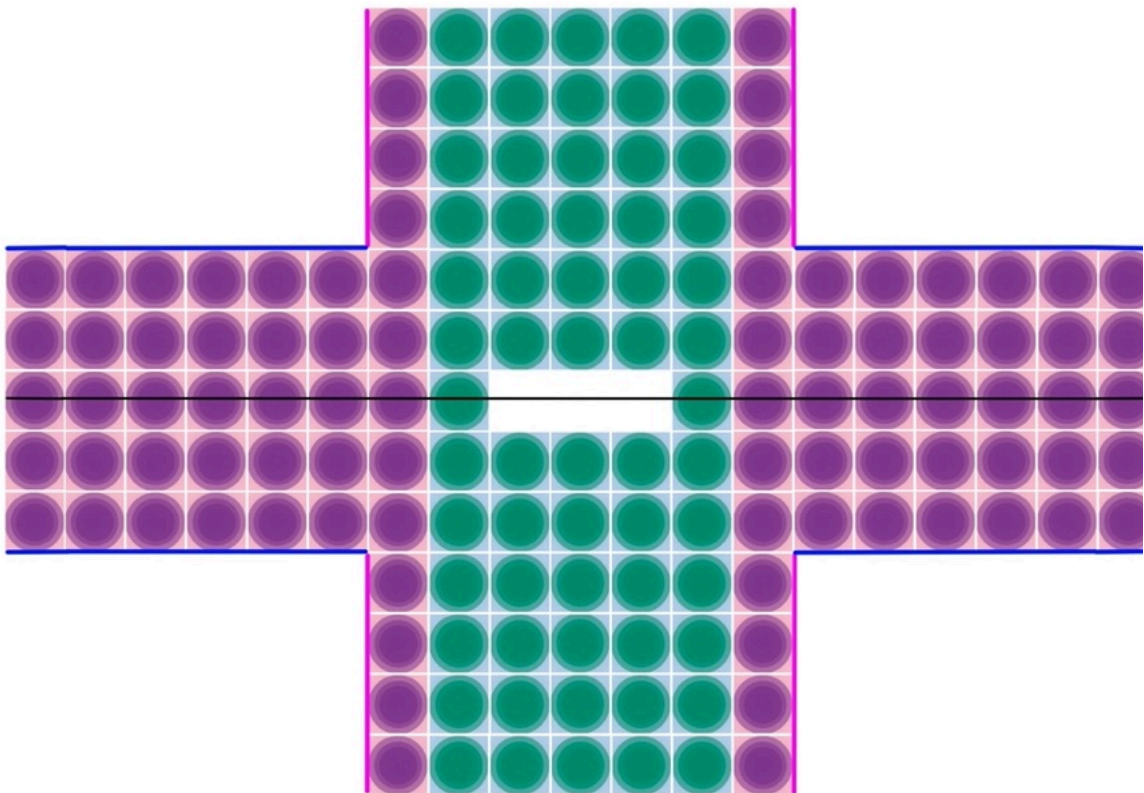
