# **Nordic Seas**

**Beanie & Cowl**

#### **MATERIALS**

2 (3) skeins of **Lollipop** colour Washington (22) for set

Crochet hook 5 mm / US H/8 for hat Crochet hook 5.5 mm / US I/9 for cowl Tapestry needle 1 snap-on pompom, 13 cm / 5.1 inch

# YARN QUALITY

**Lollipop**, Hobbii 80% acrylic, 20% wool 200 g / 7.1 oz = 350 m / 382 yds

#### **GAUGE**

**Hat:** 5 clusters of 3D wave pattern = 10 cm / 4" **Cowl:** 4.5 clusters of 3D wave pattern = 10 cm / 4"

#### **ABBREVIATIONS**

beg = beginning
bpdc = back post double crochet
ch = chain
dc = double crochet
fpdc = front post double crochet
rep = repeat
RS = right side of work
sc = single crochet
sl st = slip stitch
st(s) = stitch(es)
WS = wrong side of work
yo = yarn over hook
sk = skip

**HAT:** S (L) **COWL**: S (L)

#### **MEASUREMENTS**

HAT

**Circumference:** 46 (53.5) cm / 18 (21)"

**Depth:** 18 (21.5) cm / 7 (8.5)"

#### COWL

**Circumference:** 65 (76) cm / 25.5 (30)" **Depth:** 24 (30.5) cm / 9.5 (12)"

#### PATTERN INFORMATION

When it's chilly and you need to stay warm and look stylish, this set is for you! Full of texture, the 3D wave stitch adds a unique look that looks great with a variegated yarn. Of course, you can choose to just make the beanie or just the cowl but wearing them together will really turn heads! Cowl is worked in joined rounds. Hat is worked in joined rounds, then ribbing is worked at the end.

# **Pattern**







INFO AND TIPS
US crochet terms used throughout.

When single sts are worked one after another (without increasing or decreasing), this is given in the style "Xsc". For example, 5sc = sc in each of next 5 sts.

**Front Post Double Crochet (fpdc):** Yo, insert hook from front to back to the right of the next post, bring hook to front to the left of the post, yo and draw up a loop, [yo, draw through 2 loops] twice.

**Back Post Double Crochet (bpdc):** Yo, insert hook from back to front to the right of the next post, bring hook to back to the left of the post, yo and draw up a loop, [yo, draw through 2 loops] twice.

**Sc2tog:** Insert hook and draw up a loop, insert hook and draw up a loop in the next stitch, yo and draw through 3 loops on hook.

#### **3D Wave Pattern**

**Set-up Row 1 (RS):** Ch3 (counts as 1st dc), dc in each st to end, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. Turn.

**Set-up Row 2 (WS):** Ch3, 2dc in same st, (ch3, sk 2 dc, 3dc in next st) to end, ch3, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. Turn.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch3, 2 fpdc around dc just below the hook, (ch3, 3 fpdc into 3rd dc of group from previous row) to end, ch3, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. Turn.

**Note:** Ch-3 spaces are not counted as stitches.









#### **COWL**

# **Bottom Edge**

Using 5.5 mm / US I/9 crochet hook, ch 96 (114). Join with sl st to first ch.

**Row 1 (RS):** Ch3 (counts as 1st dc), dc in each st to end, join with sl st to beg ch-3. Turn.

Row 2: Ch2 (does not count as a st), (fpdc around next st, bpdc around next st) to end, join

with sl st to beg ch-3. Turn.

Row 3: Rep Row 2.

#### **Cowl Body**

Work Set-up Row 2 of 3D Wave Pattern once.

Work Row 1 of 3D Wave Pattern a total of 16 (22) times.

**Transition row (RS):** Ch3, 2 fpdc around dc just below the hook, (3 fpdc in 3rd dc of group from previous row) to end, join with sl st to beg ch-3. Turn.

#### **Top Edge**

**Next row (WS):** Ch3, dc in each st across, join with sl st to beg ch-3. Turn.

**Next row:** Ch2 (does not count as a st), (fpdc, bpdc) to end, join with sl st to beg ch-3. Turn.

Rep last row once more.

Fasten off.

## **FINISHING**

Weave in ends and block.









#### **HAT**

Using 5 mm / US H/8 crochet hook, ch 72 (84). Join with sl st to first ch.

Work Set-up Rows 1-2 of 3D Wave Pattern.

Work Row 1 of 3D Wave Pattern for a total of 12 (14) rows. Final row should be worked on RS.

## Crown

**Row 1 (WS):** Ch3, 2 fpdc around dc just below the hook, (ch1, 3 fpdc into 3rd dc of group from previous row) to end, ch1, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. Turn.

Row 2: Repeat Row 1.

**Row 3:** Ch3, 1 fpdc around dc just below the hook, (ch1, 2 fpdc into 3rd dc of group from previous row) to end, ch1, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. Turn. 48 (56) sts.

**Row 4:** Ch3, (Fpdc into 2nd dc of group from previous row) around, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. Turn. 24 (28) sts.

**Row 5:** (Yo, insert hook from front under 2 dc, bring hook to front, yo and draw up a loop, yo and complete dc) to end, join with sl st to top of beg ch-3. Turn. 12 (14) sts.

**Row 6:** Sc2tog around.

# Fasten off.

Cut yarn leaving a tail. Thread tail onto a tapestry needle and draw it through the tops of the last row, pulling firmly to close.















# **Brim**

Turn hat so that beg ch is at the top. Re-join yarn, adjusting for colour if desired.

**Round 1:** Ch2 (does not count as a st), (fpdc around next st, bpdc around next st) to end, join with sl st.

Rep Round 1 twice more. Fasten off.

# **FINISHING**

Weave in ends and block. Sew pompom snap to hat if desired.
