

CROCHET PATTERN



Design: Noemoncrochet | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

Seashell

(2, 2, 3) (3, 4, 4) skeins of color 07 (3, 3, 3) (4, 4, 4) skeins of color 02

Crochet hook 4.5mm / US 7 Scissors Tape measure Stitch markers Yarn needle

YARN QUALITY

Seashell, Hobbii 40% Cotton, 35% Viscose, 25% Linen 50g / 1.75 oz =150 m / 164 yds

GAUGE

15 hdc x 11 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"Important: The measurements of the gauge and the panels are blocked measurements.

SIZE

(XS, S, M) (L, XL, 2XL)

MEASUREMENTS

Recommended bust: (76, 86, 96) (106, 116, 126) cm / (30", 34", 37.5") (41.5", 45.5", 49.5")

Finished bust circumference (88, 98, 108) (118, 128, 138) cm / (34.5", 38.5", 42.5") (46", 50", 54")

Panel width: (22, 24.5, 27) (29.5, 32, 34.5) cm / (8.5", 9.5", 10.5") (11.5", 12.5", 13.5")

Panel length: (70, 75, 80) (85, 90, 95) cm / (27.5", 29.5", 31.5") (33.5", 35.5", 37.5")

Finished length from shoulder: (45, 47.5, 50) (52.5, 55, 57.5) cm / (17.5", 18.5", 19.5") (20.5", 21.5", 22.5")

The design has a positive ease of 5-15cm / 2-6". The model is wearing a size M with approx. 10 cm / 4" positive ease.

PATTERN INFORMATION

The top is made with two panels that are then joined to form a V- neck that you can adapt to the length you want for your neckline, as well as the opening of the back. Pattern includes photographs so you can follow it without difficulties.

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sl st = slip stitch

sc = single crochet

sl st (blo) = slip stitch back loop only

hdc = half double crochet

hdc (blo) = half double crochet back loop only

puff + 1ch + puff = 1 puff stitch + 1 chain + 1 puff stitch in the same stitch

FPdc = front post double crochet

rep = repeat

... repeat the instructions between * *

RS = right side

WS = wrong side

st(s) = stitch(es)

sk = skip

INFO AND TIPS

- The number of stitches on the panels is the same from start to finish, as there are no increases or decreases.
- Chains do not count as a stitch. Except those specified in the pattern.
- You can join the panels with more or less stitches depending on the opening you want for the neck.



How to work sl st (blo)

Work sl st in the back loop, the first photo indicates the loop where the sl st is worked, the second is the result.





How to work hdc (blo)

Make a yarn over and hdc in the back strand as shown in the photos.





How to work puff + 1ch + puff


Make 3 unfinished hdc in the same stitch and close all together, ch to close the stitch, another separating chain and again 3 unfinished hdc in the same stitch and close all together and ch to close the stitch.











How to work FPdc

Work double crochet taking the stitch from the previous round through the front. In the first 4 photos the sc from the previous round is taken and in the other 4 photos it is shown how the FPdc is done in front of the dc from the previous round.



















BODY

Make two equal panels.

Row 1 RS (col.07): (109, 117, 125) (133, 141, 149) ch, starting from the 2nd ch from the hook, 4 sl sts, *4 hdc, 4 sl sts* Rep *...* until the end of the row. (108, 116, 124) (132, 140, 148) sts. 1 ch, turn.



Row 2 WS: 4 sl sts (blo), *4 hdc (blo), 4 sl st (blo)*. Rep *...* until the end of the row. 2 ch, turn.





Rows 3 RS - 4 WS: 4 hdc (blo), *4 sl sts (blo), 4 hdc (blo)* Rep *...* until the end of the row. 2 ch, turn.

At the end of row 4, 1 ch, turn.





Rows 5 RS - 6 WS: 4 sl sts (blo), *4 hdc (blo), 4 sl sts (blo)*. Rep *...* until the end of the row. 1 ch, turn.

At the end of row 6, 2 ch, turn.





Rows 7 - (18, 22, 26) (30, 34, 38): rep rows 3 - 6. Color change, 2 ch, turn.

Row (19, 23, 27) (31, 35, 39 (col.02): 4 hdc (blo), *4 sl sts (blo), 4 hdc (blo)* Rep *...* until the end of the row. 2 ch (count as first st of next row), turn.

Row (20, 24, 28) (32, 36, 40): hdc throughout the entire row. 2 ch (count as first st of next row),



turn.

Row (21, 25, 29) (33, 37, 41): (12, 7, 11) (15, 10, 14) hdc in the first stitches, sk 1 st, puff + 1ch + puff, sk 1 st, *6 hdc, sk 1 st, puff + 1ch + puff, sk 1 st* Rep *...* to (12, 7, 11) (15, 10, 14) last sts, work 1 hdc in each of these last sts.



Rows (22, 26, 30) (34, 38, 42) - (28, 32, 36) (40, 44, 48): Rep previous row, working puff + 1ch + puff in the ch gap of the puffs from the previous row.



Sewing

Fold the panels in half with RS facing up. Count the stitches from the ends up and put markers on (25, 30, 35) (40, 45, 50) sts. Do the same for the front, back and sides. Join with invisible seam along the WS.







Waist (work in the round)

Round 1: With the RS facing up, insert the hook through the back join and take out yarn color 02, 1 ch and work sc throughout the round. Each sc corresponds to each row of the body pattern (not counting the 1st round) + 1 sc in each union of the center front part + 1 sc of the back. (110,126, 142) (158, 174, 190) sc. unite with sl st.



Round 2 - 13: FPdc throughout the round. Sl st.





Round 14: ch 1, sl st throughout the round, join with sl st and finish off.



You can work more or less rounds 2-13, up to your desired length.

Neck

Round 1: Insert the hook into the center back, RS facing up, and work sl st the entire round.
