## MATERIALS

1 skein of **Unicorn** color 108

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G/6

# YARN QUALITY

Unicorn, Hobbii
75% Superwash Merino Wool, 25% Polyamide
100 g / 3.5 oz = 400 m / 437 yds

## GAUGE (hdc)

22 hdc x 15 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

## **ABBREVIATIONS**

ch = chain sc = single crochet sl st = slip stitch hdc = half double crochet

# SIZE

One size

# **MEASUREMENTS**

Neckline circumference: 70 cm / 27.5" Length: 30 cm / 11.75"

The length is customizable. Remember to buy an extra skein, if you want to make a longer capelet.

This capelet is designed to be flowy and drapey, it naturally adapts to all sizes. Instead of a fixed width, the open mesh pattern allows it to sit comfortably on any body shape.

# **PATTERN INFORMATION**

The Julietta Capelet is a stylish crochet pattern worked vertically with a fun, airy mesh design. You can customize the length to suit your style, wear it short for a chic look or longer! Made with hand-dyed yarn, its unique colors stand out beautifully over a neutral top. The fabric is soft and lightweight, making it a perfect statement accessory for any season. Whether you're dressing up or keeping it casual, this capelet adds a bold yet effortless touch to your outfit!

# Pattern



#### NECKLINE

Chain 120 stitches, making sure the chain is not twisted. Join with a slip stitch (sl st) to form a ring. Ensure the chain is loose enough to sit comfortably around the neck. Feel free to adjust the size. R1: ch 1, hdc in each stitch around. Sl st to join the round. (120)

#### BODY

Now, create the vertical mesh pattern by crocheting a long chain. The length of this chain determines the capelet's final length. (Must be a multiple of 24)

Example: If you want a short capelet crochet 96 ch. This short cape will measure around 30 cm / 11.75" in length.


R1: ch 1, start crocheting from the 2nd ch from the hook. (hdc 8, ch 16, skip 16 sts) x 4 times. Once back at the neckline, sl st into the next 2 neckline stitches to attach the row. (96) Now turn your work and continue with row 2.

R2: ch 4, skip 4 sts, (hdc 8, ch 16, skip 16 sts) x 3 times, hdc 8, ch 12, skip 12 sts. (96) Continue repeating Rows 1 and 2 until you work all the way around the neckline and return to the first row.

#### **FINISHING THE CAPELET**

Once you've worked all the way around the neckline and completed your last row, it's time to close the capelet. Fasten off and weave in any loose ends. To join the first and last row, reattach your yarn at four different points where the mesh sections align. At each joining point: skip 4 chains in the 16-ch spaces of both the first and last row. SI st 8 stitches together (matching the stitches from both rows). Cut the yarn and weave in the ends.





**Extra tip:** If you want to add a unique touch, try adding beads to the bottom fringes! The extra weight will slightly change the drape of the capelet, giving it a beautiful structure.
