MATERIALS

2 (2, 2, 2, 3, 3, 3, 3, 4) skeins of **Unicorn Solid** color 05 (MC) 1 (1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1, 1) skein of **Unicorn** color 102 (CC)

Circular needle 4 mm, 60 cm / US 6, 24" Circular needle 4 mm, 40 cm / US 6, 16" Circular needle 3.75 mm, 60 cm / US 5, 24" Stitch marker Tapestry needle Scissors

YARN QUALITY

Unicorn Solid, Hobbii 75 % Superwash Merino Wool, 25 % Polyamide 100 g / 3.5 oz = 400 m / 437 yds

GAUGE

26 sts x 26 rnds = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4" in colorwork Stockinette Stitch pattern on 4 mm / US 6 20 sts x 30 rnds = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4" in MC Stockinette Stitch pattern on 4 mm / US 6

SIZE

XS (S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, 4XL, 5XL)

To fit 75 (85, 95, 105, 115, 125, 135, 145, 155) cm / 30 (34, 38, 42, 46, 50, 54, 58, 62)" chest circumference Shown in size M on model with a 90 cm / 36" chest circumference

MEASUREMENTS

Collar Circumference: 54 (54.5, 58, 55.5, 58.5, 57.5, 64, 68, 72) cm / 21.5 (21.75, 23.25, 22.25, 23.5, 23, 25.5, 27.25, 28.75)" Hem Circumference: 106 (122.5, 129.5, 145.5, 152.5, 168.5, 184.5, 199, 212.5) cm / 42.5 (49, 51.75, 58.25, 61, 67.5, 73.75, 79.5, 85)" Length (shoulder to hem): 38.5 (38.5, 38.5, 40, 40, 40, 41, 41, 41) cm /15.5 (15.5, 15.5, 16, 16, 16, 16.5, 16.5, 16.5)"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This capelet design is knit in the round from the top down beginning with a generous funnel neck collar (knit in the main color in Stockinette Stitch) that folds down to reveal Reverse Stockinette Stitch. The body of the capelet is worked in Stockinette Stitch like a seamless yoke sweater with three sections of increases beginning at the neckline, alternating sections of the circle colorwork pattern (in main color and contrasting color) and a skinny section in the main color. Each colorwork section is larger than the section before. The hem is worked flat on smaller needles in Garter Stitch with side slits to make wearing the capelet more comfortable. A schematic can be found at the end of the pattern.

ABBREVIATIONS

BO = bind off CC = contrasting color CO = cast on K = knit Kfb = knit through the front and back of the next stitch (increase 1 st) Inc = increase MC = main color P = Purl Pm = place marker Rep = repeat Rnd(s) = round(s) RS = right side SI = slip St(s) = stitch(es) WS = wrong side

Stockinette Stitch (in the round)

All Rnds: Knit.

Garter Stitch (flat)


All Rows: Knit.



Tips

- Use your chest circumference to determine which size to make. The sample shown in the pictures is the size M on a model with a 90 cm / 36" chest circumference. If you are concerned about how the garment will fit, do the following. Use a measuring tape and wrap it around your upper body so that it includes both your chest and arms. Compare this number to the hem circumference listed in MEASUREMENTS. There should be 12.5-25 cm / 5-10" of positive ease for comfort. The model is wearing the capelet with 17 cm / 6.75" of positive ease.
- 2. Change to longer circular needles when the stitches feel too scrunched on the needle.
- 3. Optional: Use a removable stitch marker to denote Row 1 of the colorwork chart. I usually place this stitch marker a few stitches to the left of the Beginning of Round marker so that it is easier to see and count the rows.


Schematic



- a. Collar Circumference: 54 (54.5, 58, 55.5, 58.5, 57.5, 64, 68, 72) cm / 21.5 (21.75, 23.25, 22.25, 23.5, 23, 25.5, 27.25, 28.75)"
- b. Upper Shoulder Circumference: 62.5 (71.5, 76, 85.5, 90, 99, 111, 117.5, 124.5) cm / 25 (28.5, 30.5, 34.25, 36, 39.75, 44.25, 47, 50)"
- c. Upper Chest Circumference: 83 (97, 101.5, 115.5, 120, 134, 147.5, 157, 168.5) cm / 33.25 (38.75, 40.5, 46.25, 48, 53.5, 59, 62.75, 67.5)"
- d. Lower Chest / Hem Circumference: 106 (122.5, 129.5, 145.5, 152.5, 168.5, 184.5, 199, 212.5) cm / 42.5 (49, 51.75, 58.25, 61, 67.5, 73.75, 79.5, 85)"
- e. Collar Length: 20 cm / 8"
- f. Body Length: 38.5 (38.5, 38.5, 40, 40, 40, 41, 41, 41) cm / 15.5 (15.5, 15.5, 16, 16, 16, 16, 16.5, 16.5, 16.5)"

INSTRUCTIONS

Collar

With MC, CO 108 (109, 116, 111, 117, 115, 128, 136, 144) sts on larger 40 cm / 16" circular needles using the long-tail cast-on method or preferred method of stretchy cast-on. Pm, join to work in the rnd.

Work in Stockinette Stitch pattern for 20 cm / 8".

Yoke

Section 1: MC only

Next Rnd *for XS size only*: Knit. Inc Rnd *for S-5XL sizes only*: (- (K6, 6, 2, 2, 1, 1, 1, 1) kfb) rep to last - (4, 4, 0, 0, 1, 0, 0, 0) sts, k-(4, 4, 0, 0, 1, 0, 0, 0). [108 (124, 132, 148, 156, 172, 192, 204, 216) sts total] All sizes: Knit 1 rnd in MC. Inc Rnd *for all sizes*: (K1, kfb) rep to end. [162 (186, 198, 222, 234, 258, 288, 306, 324) sts total] All sizes: Knit 1 rnd in MC.

Section 2: MC and CC

Work Rnds 1-6 of the Colorwork Chart in Stockinette Stitch twice, repeating the 6-st pattern 27 (31, 33, 37, 39, 43, 48, 51, 54) times across each rnd. Repeat Rnd 1 of the Colorwork Chart one more time.

Section 3: MC only

Knit 1 rnd in MC. Next Rnd *for XS, M, XL, 3XL, and 4XL sizes only*: Knit 1 rnd in MC. Inc Rnd *for S, L, 2XL, and 5XL sizes only*: (K- (61, -, 73, -, 85, -, -, 107), kfb) rep to end. [162 (189, 198, 225, 234, 261, 288, 306, 327) sts total] Inc Rnd *for all sizes*: (K2, kfb) rep to end. [216 (252, 264, 300, 312, 348, 384, 408, 436 sts total]



Next Rnd *for XS, S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 3XL, and 4XL sizes only*: Knit 1 rnd in MC. Next Rnd *for 5XL size only*: (K217, kfb) two times. [216 (252, 264, 300, 312, 348, 384, 408, 438 sts total]

Section 4: MC and CC

Work Rnds 1-6 of the Colorwork Chart in Stockinette Stitch four times, repeating the 6-st pattern 36 (42, 44, 50, 52, 58, 64, 68, 73) times across each rnd. Repeat Rnd 1 of the Colorwork Chart one more time.

Section 5: MC only

Knit 1 rnd in MC.

Inc Rnd *for XS, M, XL, 4XL, and 5XL sizes only*: (K53 (-, 65, -, 77, -, -, 101, 218), kfb) rep to end. [220 (252, 268, 300, 316, 348, 384, 412, 440) sts total] Next Rnd *for S, L, 2XL, and 3XL sizes only*: Knit 1 rnd in MC. Inc Rnd *for all sizes*: (K3, kfb) rep to end. [275 (315, 335, 375, 395, 435, 480, 515, 550) sts total] Inc Rnd *for XS, S, M, L, XL, 2XL, 4XL, and 5XL sizes only*: (K274 (104, 334, 124, 394, 144, -, 514, 274), kfb) rep 0 (2, 0, 2, 0, 2, -, 0, 1) times. [276 (318, 336, 378, 396, 438, 480, 516, 552) sts total] Next Rnd *for 3XL size only*: Knit 1 rnd in MC.

Section 6: MC and CC

Work Rnds 1-6 of the Colorwork Chart in Stockinette Stitch six times, repeating the 6-st pattern 46 (53, 56, 63, 66, 73, 80, 86, 92) times across each rnd. Repeat Rnd 1 of the Colorwork Chart one more time.

Section 7: MC only

Knit 2 rnds in MC.

Front Hem

Change to smaller circular needles. The hem is worked flat as follows: Row 1 (RS): K138 (159, 168, 189, 198, 219, 240, 258, 276) and turn work. Row 2 (WS): With the yarn in front, sl2 purlwise, bring yarn to back, knit to last 2 sts, with the yarn in front, sl2 purlwise. Rep Rows 1-2 until hem measures 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6, 7.5, 7.5, 7.5) cm / 2 (2, 2, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5, 3, 3, 3)" ending with a WS row. BO.

Back Hem

With smaller circular needles join yarn with RS facing. Row 1 (RS): K138 (159, 168, 189, 198, 219, 240, 258, 276) and turn work. Row 2 (WS): With the yarn in front, sl2 purlwise, bring yarn to back, knit to last 2 sts, with the yarn in front, sl2 purlwise.



Rep Rows 1-2 until hem measures 5 (5, 5, 6, 6, 6, 7.5, 7.5, 7.5) cm / 2 (2, 2, 2.5, 2.5, 2.5, 3, 3, 3)" ending with a WS row. BO.

Finishing

Weave in all loose ends. Wet block to measurements.
