



CROCHET PATTERN

Venus

Shawl

Design: Noemoncrochet | Hobbii Design



MATERIALS

2 skeins of **Dahlia** color 03

Crochet hook 4 mm / US G-6

YARN QUALITY

Dahlia, Hobbii 100% Cotton 200 g / 7.1 oz = 800 m / 875 yds

GAUGE

16 dc x 10 rows = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4'' x 4'' Important: all measurements given have been blocked using the steam technique

ABBREVIATIONS

ch = chain

sc = single crochet

dc = double crochet

tr = treble crochet

crossed dc = crossed double crochet

5 dc shell = 5 double crochet in the same stitch

puff = puff stitch

sc in 3rd loop = sc work in the third loop

5 tr shell = 5 tr in the same stitch

3 dc+p+3 dc = 3 double crochet, 1 picot

stitch and 3 double crochet in the same

stitch.

tr+3 ch+tr = treble crochet, 3 ch and treble crochet in the same stitch.

sk = skip

st(s) = stitch(es)

ss = slip stitch

RS / WS = right side / wrong side

... = repeat the instructions between **

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Width: 80 cm / 31.5" Length: 177 cm / 69.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

The Venus shawl is a light and colorful shawl. The changing colors of the yarn and the different stitches keep you hooked on the project.

INFO AND TIPS

You can modify the length of your shawl by working more or fewer repetitions.

All turning chains count as a stitch.

In rows 8 and 10 work with a little less tension to facilitate the work in the following rows where you work sc in the 3rd loop.

The number of stitches is a multiple of 10+2.

I started the first ball from the inside, I joined the second ball starting from the outside to match the colors.

How to work sc in 3rd loop:

The first photograph indicates the strand in which the sc is to be made.












How to work puff stitch:

Make 3 half double crochets without finishing, close all together, ch to close the stitch.



How to work crossed dc:

Skip 1 stitch, 1 dc, 1dc ahead until the stitch you skipped.











How to work 3dc+p+3dc:

Make 3 dc in the same st, 3 ch, join with slip stitch with the 1st ch from the base of the 3ch (indicated in the 3rd photo), and finish with 3 dc in the same st.





MAIN PATTERN

Row 1: 133 ch, start in 2nd ch from hook, 1 sc in each stitch (132 sts). 3 ch, turn. Row 2: sk 2 sts, 5 dc shell, * sk 4 sts, 5 dc shell *. Rep *...* to last 3 sts, sk 2 sts, 1 dc in last st. 5 ch, turn (the first 3 ch of turn count as dc of the next row)



Row 3: sk 2 sts, puff, * 4 ch, sk 4 sts, puff *. Rep *...*to last 3 sts, sk 2 sts, 1 dc in last st. 3 ch, turn.



Row 4: 5 dc shell on top of the puff from the previous row until the end. Dc in the last st. 5 ch, turn. (the first 3 ch of turn count as dc of the next row)



Row 5: rep row 3. 4 ch, turn.



Row 6: sk 2 sts, tr+3ch+tr over the puff from the previous round until you reach the last 3 sts, sk 2 sts, tr in the last st. 4 ch, turn.



Row 7: 5 tr shell in the 3ch gap of the previous row until the end. 1 ch, turn



Row 8: sc to end. 1ch, turn.





Row 9: sc in 3rd loop to end, normal sc in last st. 3 ch, turn. In the second photo you can see how the RS looks.





Row 10: dc crossed to end, dc in last st. 1 ch, turn



Row 11: sc in 3rd loop to end, 1 normal sc in last st. 3 ch, turn. In the second photo you can see how the RS looks.





Row 12 - 141: Rep from row 2 to row 11. Row 142: ch 3 (counts as first st), sk 2 st, 3dc+p+3dc,* sk 4 sts, 3dc+p+3dc *. Rep *...* to last 3 sts, sk 2sts, 1 dc in last st.





In this way we would have one end already finished.

With the RS facing up, join the thread from the central part of the skein so that the colors of the initial chain match in the corner of the other end and repeat row 142.
