



CROCHET PATTERN

Jonah Boho Rug

MATERIALS

2 skeins each of **Friends Ribbon**, colors 16, 28, 79, 98, 120, 124 1 skein of **Friends Ribbon** color 05 2 skeins of **Friends Ribbon Print** color 03 1 skein each of **Friends Ribbon Print**, colors 06, 07, 08

Note: Any Friends Ribbon and Friends Ribbon Print colors can be used based on preference. If using fewer colors, a total of 8 skeins of Friends Ribbon is needed.

Crochet hook 8 mm / US L/11 Stitch markers Tapestry needle

YARN QUALITY

Friends Ribbon, Hobbii 100% cotton 250 g / 8.8 oz = 125 m / 136 yds

Friends Ribbon Print, Hobbii 100% cotton 200 g / 7.1 oz = 100 m / 109 yds

GAUGE

9 hdc blo x 8 rounds = 10 cm x 10 cm / 4" x 4"

ABBREVIATIONS

3lo = work into third loop at back ch = chain dc = double crochet hdc = half double crochet sc = single crochet sl st = slip stitch st(s) = stitch(es)

SIZE

One size

MEASUREMENTS

Total diameter: 102 cm / 40" Centre circle diameter: 70 cm / 27.5" Outer circle diameter: 16.5 cm / 6.5"

PATTERN INFORMATION

This boho style rug will make you smile when you walk into the room. It is bright, charming, whimsical and will start so many conversations! Of course, if you don't like the bright color, choose neutral colors of the Friends Ribbon Yarn which also makes a stunning piece. When I first showed it to a colleague, he said "that's not a rug- it's art". Centre circle is worked continuously in a spiral. Outer circles are worked in joined rounds.

Note! The exact color changes for the pattern in the photos are not provided. You simply change colors as desired.

INFO AND TIPS
US crochet terms used throughout

When single sts are worked one after another (without increasing or decreasing), this is given in the style "Xsc". For example, 5sc = sc in each of next 5 sts.

3lo: Work stitch into the 3rd loop at the back of the work.

Center Circle

Center Circle is worked in a spiral. Place a st marker into the first st of each round, moving the marker up as you work. Change colours as desired.

Make magic ring.

Round 1: Ch1, 10hdc in ring. Do not join with sl st.

Beginning with Rnd 2, work all sts into the 3rd loop at back.

Round 2: (2hdc 3lo in next st) to end. 20 sts.

Round 3: (2hdc 3lo in next st, hdc 3lo in next st) to end. 10 sts increased.

Round 4: (2hdc 3lo in next st, hdc 3lo in next 2 sts) to end.

Round 5: (2hdc 3lo in next st, hdc 3lo in next 3 sts) to end.

Round 6: (2hdc 3lo in next st, hdc 3lo in next 4 sts) to end.

Round 7: (2hdc 3lo in next st, hdc 3lo in next 5 sts) to end.

Continue in this manner, adding 1 more st between increases each round, until you have completed **Round 23:** (2hdc 3lo in next st, hdc 3lo in next 21 sts) to end. 230 sts.

Note: Increases should be worked into the first st of the previous round's increases.

Work 3 rounds straight without increases in hdc 3lo.

Work 1 round straight in sc 3lo.

Work 1 round straight in sc, working through both top loops of previous round.

Place remaining st on hold while working outer circles.









Outer Circles (make 18)

Worked in joined rounds.

Make magic ring.

Rnd 1: Ch3 (does not count as a st), 12dc in ring, join with sl st to beg ch. 12 dc.

Rnd 2: Ch3, (2dc in each st) around, join with sl st to beg ch. 24 dc.

Rnd 3: Ch3, (2dc in next st, 1dc in next st) around, join with sl st. 36 dc.

Rnd 4: Ch3, (2dc in next st, 1dc in next 2 sts) around, join with sl st. 48 dc.

Fasten off, leaving a 30 cm / 12" tail on each circle for assembly.

Assembly

Using the yarn tails, join outer circles in a strip, attaching each circle opposite to the end of round.

Work 1 round of sl st around Center Circle (working through both legs of previous round), joining outer circles by sl st into the edge of the outer circles, approximately every 12 stitches of Center Circle.

Weave in remaining ends and block.
